Synopsis:

Narrative:

On 7-23-19 at 0730hrs, I was working uniformed patrol as a two-person car (R084) when I was dispatched to the train tracks located at 6th Ave and N Wilton Rd for a male who jumped in front of a passing train which was being reported by SMITH, ERIC to SS911 dispatch. Dispatch advised that W/SMITH believed that male (later identified as CARTER, KEVAN) jumped in front of the train intentionally, was believed to be dead and laying on the other side of the tracks.

We arrived on scene at 0738hrs with Tacoma Fire already there. V/CARTER was laying in between the two set of tracks with his right foot slightly resting on far left set of tracks. V/CARTER's right arm was pinned under his body and his left arm had a significant laceration to the forearm. Severe head trauma was visible to the right side of V/CARTER's head above the right eyebrow. A significant amount of what appeared to be V/CARTER's brain and skull fragments were scattered 20 feet down the tracks. Fire pronounced V/CARTER deceased and left the scene.

Sgt. O'KEEFE responded to the scene.

I contacted W/SMITH who stated he was standing on the sidewalk between the Steamer's restaurant parking lot fence and the activated railroad crossing arm. The audible alarm and the crossing arm were activated by a freight train that was traveling northbound on the far right set of tracks (it was later determined that the train consisted of 115 railroad cars.) As the train approached, W/SMITH stated a black male came up on W/SMITH's left side and jumped in front of the train and was struck. W/SMITH stated it looked like V/CARTER was attempting to "beat" the train but also appeared that V/CARTER intentionally jumped in front of the train. W/SMITH then called 911.

Another witness, HELMBERGER, PETER, stated he was walking his dog when he heard the audible alarm for the train crossing activate. W/HELMBERGER was on the sidewalk directly across the street from the Beach Tavern (8612 S 6th Ave) which is located about 25 yards south east of the railroad crossing. W/HELMBERGER saw two men (a black male and a white male) near the railroad tracks as the train

approached. According to W/HELMBERGER, as the trained approached the intersection of 6th Ave and N Wilton Rd, the black male jumped in front of the train like "Superman" and was struck. W/HELMBERGER stated that it appeared V/CARTER timed the moment the train entered the intersection and jumped in front of the train.

After speaking with W/HELMBERGER, DION, JASON approached me and stated he saw V/CARTER earlier that morning around 0630hrs standing by the Steamer's parking lot fence which is located northeast of railroad crossing. O/DION stated that V/CARTER appeared to be upset and staring out into the water. O/DION saw V/CARTER return to a vehicle (WA LIC#BAW8708) that was parked across the street directly in front of the Beach Tavern where O/DION works. O/DION left work around 0700hrs and returned home prior to the incident.

The vehicle (WA LIC#BAW8708) that O/DION described was still parked in the parking lot across from the beach tavern. Records check of the vehicle listed V/CARTER as the registered owner.

PPO SKAANES (F398) made contact with the train engineer and conductor. See PPO SKAANES supplemental in regards to statements made.

Forensics VELEZ, DONOVAN (1930) was dispatched to photograph and document the scene.

Pierce County Medical Examiner ATZET, JACOB #32 was called to the scene and arrived at 0828hrs.

While on scene, dispatch advised that the mother of V/CARTER had called SS911 dispatch to report V/CARTER as missing. According to V/CARTER's mother he was last seen checking out of the Wellfound Behavior Hospital located at 3402 S 19th St in Tacoma at 0200hrs this morning.

After forensics and the medical examiner were finished processing the scene, V/CARTER was rolled over and placed in a body bag at 0850hrs. On V/CARTER's left arm was what appeared to be a hospital bracelet. The name CARTER, KEVAN DOB 12/28/1989 was clearly printed on the wristband with the date 7/23/19 and the word WELLFOUND.

V/CARTER was placed in the medical examiner van.

Burlington Northern train personal arrived on scene to begin their investigation.

Burlington Northern Police Officer HUNTER, EVAN 623, responded to the scene and was provided the incident case number.

After leaving the scene, dispatch advised that V/CARTER's father CARTER SR, KEVAN was on scene where the incident took place and wanted police contact. We returned to the scene and were contacted by V/CARTER's Aunt and Uncle which were informed of the incident. TPD Chaplain HOGAN, PAT was already on scene and had made contact with V/CARTER's father. Prior to leaving, more family member arrived on scene.

Synopsis

Narrative:

On 7/23/2019 at 0741 hours I was dispatched to 6th Avenue and N. Wilton Road to assist R084, PPS CHELL and PPO PINGUL, on a possible suicide. R084 originally responded to this area concerning an individual that had run out in front of a Burlington Northern train. Upon arrival I walked N/B along the railroad tracks to contact the Engineer and Conductor of the train concerning the incident. Upon arrival at the engine, I noted that it was approximately 100 yards north of the northern most Titlow Park pond.

I contacted ANDERSON who is the train engineer and who was waiting for me as I approached. ANDERSON stepped off of the train so that we could hear each other easier. ANDERSON provided me with his information and added that he had been employed with Burlington Northern Railroad for approximately 9 years, and has been an engineer for the last 7 ½ years.

ANDERSON related that at approximately 0730 hours he and the Conductor of the train, later identified as KRAFT, were traveling N/B along the railroad tracks where Wilton Rd and 6th Avenue meet. ANDERSON said that he observed the victim, later identified as CARTER, standing on the east side of the track as they were approaching. ANDERSON estimated that the train was traveling approximately 33 mph. ANDERSON added that it looked like CARTER was a jogger waiting for the train to pass by the way he was

dressed. ANDERSON said that nothing appeared out of the ordinary. ANDERSON related that right when they were approaching the location where CARTER was, CARTER stepped onto the track in front of the engine at the last moment. ANDERSON said that it appeared to him that CARTER stepped onto the tracks and then leaned into the front of the engine as it struck him. ANDERSON said that the brakes were applied immediately and they came to rest at their current location. ANDERSON said that they contacted their supervisors immediately as well.

ANDERSON walked back onto the train and I then spoke with KRAFT who is the train's conductor and who stepped off of the train to talk to me as well. KRAFT said that he had been employed by Burlington Northern Railroad for 7 years as a conductor. KRAFT related the same story as ANDERSON and said that their speed was approximately 35 mph. KRAFT added that he also thought that CARTER was a jogger just waiting to cross the tracks after the train had passed. KRAFT related that he also observed CARTER step in front of the train at the last minute, but was unsure if he leaned toward the engine. KRAFT said that they were just waiting for Burlington Northern Personnel to contact them.

Both ANDERSON and KRAFT said that they were fine for the moment and did not request a chaplain when I offered one to them. Both appeared to be in disbelief on what just happened to them, and both stated that this was the first time this has happened to either of them. I provided KRAFT with a case number and then walked back to my patrol vehicle and secured from the scene. Both added that they thought CARTER'S actions were on purpose.
