| Event Summary: |
| On August 31, 2019 at approximately 4:03 a.m., Jason Foust BNSF conductor advised that while approaching the railroad crossing at Boulevard Park heading southbound, he noticed what appeared to be a cone of some sort laying in the middle of the train track. Jason Foust stated the train was traveling at approximately 35 mies per hour. As the train approached the object, he noticed it was a person laying on the track. Jason Foust stated that he and the engineer, Ryan Arganti, tried to stop the train before hitting the pedestrian, but they were unable to stop in time. |
| Once the train stopped, Jason Foust exited the train to meet law enforcement at the train crossing. Law enforcement approached the train track and observed a male subject approximately 20 to 30 feet south of the train crossing laying underneath the train. The male subject received severe blunt force trauma to the head and what appeared to be a severed foot or leg. Bellingham Fire Department personnel arrived on scene moments later and confirmed what appeared to be an obvious death. |

| Bayview Drive, USDOT 084805C is in the city of Bellingham, in Whatcom county. This crossing is located in downtown Bellingham |
| and is highly traversed. The crossing is equipped with lights and gates which were functioning properly at the time of the incident. |

On 08/31/2019 at approximately 0408 hours, I was dispatched to the 400 block of Bayview Dr for a train vs pedestrian.

I arrived on scene and contacted train conductor, JASON FOUST (W1). JASON FOUST (W1) advised that while approaching the railroad crossing at BOULEVARD PARK (R1) heading southbound, he noticed what appeared to be a cone of some sort laying in the middle of the train track. JASON FOUST (W1) stated that the train was traveling at approximately 35 mph.

As the train became closer to the object, he noticed it was a person laying on the track. JASON FOUST (W1) stated that he and the engineer, RYAN ARGANTI (W2), tried to stop the train before hitting the pedestrian, but it was too late.

Once the train was stopped, JASON FOUST (W1) exited the train to meet law enforcement at the train crossing.

I approached the train track and observed a male subject approximately 20 to 30 feet south of the train crossing laying underneath the train. The male subject received severe blunt force trauma to the head and what appeared to be a severed foot or leg. Bellingham Fire Department personnel arrived on scene moments later and confirmed what appeared to be an obvious death.

Ofc Sturlaugson and I walked down the track and contacted RYAN ARGANTI (W2) in the lead engine. RYAN ARGANTI (W2) confirmed that he is the engineer for the train and is responsible in making the train move (drive). RYAN ARGANTI (W2) advised that he noticed something on the train track that looked like a possible plastic bag or backpack. As the train approached the item, he observed a person laying parallel in the train track. The unknown subject appeared to be laying on his stomach with his head on the track and his legs hanging off of the train crossing platform.

RYAN ARGANTI (W2) stated he attempted to stop the train, but was unable before colliding into the subject.

I walked around the front of the train and observed blood and other matter on the front panel of the train engine.

I walked around the other side of the train and noticed what appeared to be a foot or partial leg detached from the body next to the track.

I walked down to BOULEVARD PARK (R1) and located an unoccupied red Honda Civic WA/BLL2255. The registered owner is MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2) who has a local address at 500 STERLING DR, APT 106. The deceased person from the fatality collision did not appear to match the DOL photograph of MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2). Officer Keller and Officer Huyber to contact MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2) at 500 STERLING DR, APT 106. No answer at the residence, however, there appeared to be a parking space for the unit that was missing a vehicle.

Other officers on scene located possible phone numbers for MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2) and were unsuccessful in making contact. They also attempted to contact MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2)'s father via phone and that was also unsuccessful.

At this time, the victim remains unidentified.

On 08-31-19, I was asked to make NOK with the family of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). After getting a positive ID from CSI Kingery and EIDO DeRuiter, I asked that records make a teletype with the appropriate information for the local jurisdiction and let them know of the death of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1).

A short time later, I had a message on my VM from Pinal County Deputy Pacheco #609 who stated that when he went to the given location (W.Baca Rd) he was directed to another residence in Glendale AZ which ended up being a sister. He advised her of the death of her brother and that she could call me with any questions. A very short time later, I heard from ERNASTINE GUILLEN (C2) who resides in Glendale AZ and who wanted to know some things.

At first, she wouldn't believe that it was her brother JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) that was dead. She stated that the family was together in AZ for their father's 95 birthday celebration, so her brother that lives up in Bellingham with him, DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) was down in AZ with them. Once I advised her that we had his AZ ID and then made a positive ID off of his fingerprint, she accepted that it was her brother. She stated that her brother kept to himself and was not involved in anything he shouldn't be. I was then directed to talk to DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) who is the older brother of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) who lives in Bellingham on King St.

I had a brief conversation with him, wherein he said that his wife, ELESE GUILLEN (C5) was still in town and he had called her and asked that she go over to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) house and see if he was there. She apparently knocked on the door for awhile, and no one answered. I was then advised to go to his house and his wife would be there and show me where JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was staying. Upon making contact with her, I asked what she could tell me about her brother in law, and she stated that there wasn't much too tell. He came here from Arizona about eight months ago, and has been minding his own business and working with his brother at Gundies. I asked her if he had any addiction or mental health issues, and she stated that he drank beer but doesn't drink all the time. She stated that he had nothing officially diagnosed, but he had some anxiety issues and didn't like being around large crowds. Both ELESE GUILLEN (C5) and all of the other members of the family wanted to see the body, and asked how he died.

I told them that I didn't want to give them any more information than they wanted, and they insisted on knowing cause of death, which I explained to them was his having been struck by a freight train. I advised them that he was struck while laying on the tracks and we didn't know if it was intentional on his part or he had tripped etc. I further advised them that the body was being held at the medical examiners office pending autopsy which will occur in the coming days.

ELESE GUILLEN (C5) then brought me to 1300 Texas #5 at the Westminster Apts and she indicated that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) lived at this location, by himself. She further stated that he did not have a car, but rode his bicycle to where he needed to get to. I confirmed with her that she did not have a key, and she stated that she did not. I then went to the front door of the apartment and confirmed that it was locked, and it was. The small window by the door was closed, but a bedroom window was slid open, but unless you had an extension ladder, you couldn't reach

the window.

While I was getting ready to leave, I was called by ROBERT GUILLEN (C3) (another brother in Birch Bay) who wanted me to know that he was texting/talking to the guy that had his brothers cell phone and he said that his brother had been involved in a fight last night while he was out. No sooner was I on the phone with ROBERT GUILLEN (C3), a male I had not seen on this call thus far, walked up to me with his young child and said that he was the guy with JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) cell phone and was the guy that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) went out drinking with.

I then contacted this male, who identified himself as HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4). He stated that he and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had been out drinking last night at several bars, but around closing time or just before, they went down to the Kambucha Town bar. While there, JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) apparently got into a verbal disagreement with several (eight supposedly) guys and HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) stated that he had to step in and tell the guys to back off. Seeing that there was going to be a problem if they stayed there, HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) brought JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) over to State St for pizza (believed to be Rudy's) to forget about those guys. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) stated that when he turned around he saw that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was gone, and when he looked for him, he saw that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was getting into another fight with the same guys as before.

HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) stated that he and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) began to fight these eight guys, but JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) ultimately disengaged with them and went wondering off while HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) was still fighting them. Once the fight stopped the guys that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) was fighting apologized, and left the area. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) stated that he picked up the left shoe of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1), his black sunglasses which were broken and was handed his cell phone from some kid who was in the area. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) stated that he had no idea who this kid was.

HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) then stated that he went walking all over downtown (believed to be between 0300 to 0400 hrs) looking for JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) but when he couldn't find him, he thought he must have gotten back home, so he walked from downtown to the 1300 Texas and knocked on his apartment door with no success. Figuring he was passed out somewhere, HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) went to his residence and went to bed, as he was going to be getting his son for the day, and he wanted to be awake for it. I then collected the shoe, broken glasses and cell phone of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). As a courtesy to HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) I brought he and his young son down to the Herald Building at his request.

I then responded back to the PD where I impounded all of the aforementioned items given to me by HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4).

Phone was placed into airplane mode. Number to phone is 360-305-5804.

Nothing follows at this time.

At approximately 0408 hours on 08/31/2019, Officer Longbottom, Officer Sturlaugson, Officer Keller, Officer Huyber, and I responded to the report of a freight train versus pedestrian collision at the Bayview Drive entrance to BOULEVARD PARK (R1). Officers arrived about seven minutes later and met with the train conductor, JAN FOUST (W1), who directed them to the body which remained on the railroad track under one of the boxcars. The lifeless body was said to have extreme head trauma and a severed leg or foot.

According to JASON FOUST (W1), the person had been laying prone between the rails of the railroad track with their head facing the oncoming southbound train. JASON FOUST (W1) said that the engineer applied the emergency brake upon recognizing that there was a person on the track, however, the freight train was about a mile long and couldn't stop in time.

Bellingham Fire Department personnel responded to the scene and pronounced the person deceased.

At this point I notified the DSO, Lieutenant Monson, of the fatality collision and obtained his authorization for additional investigative resources. Evidence & ID Officer deRuiter, Investigator Kingery, Traffic Officer Wright, and Traffic Officer Stewart were subsequently called into service to assist with the investigation. BNSF Police responded to the scene as well.

Officers discovered an unoccupied red Honda Civic (WA lic. BLL2255) parked inside of Boulevard Park that was thought to possibly be associated with the deceased person whose identify was unknown. No suicide note or anything else noteworthy was observed inside of the car. A DOL inquiry identified MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2) as the registered owner, so Officer Keller and Officer Huyber went to his last known address in an attempt to contact him or anyone else having knowledge of the vehicle. There was no answer at the residence and officers were unable to contact MILTON JIMENZ FACUNDO (R2) by telephone either.

I remained at the scene until Evidence & ID Officer deRuiter arrived. I informed him of the facts and circumstances known to me regarding the collision and he assumed supervisory control of the investigation thereafter.

On 08/31/2019 at approximately 0424 hours, I received a callout request for a Crime Scene Investigator.

I arrived on scene with Evidence and ID Officer DeRuiter. I spoke with officers and the sergeant on scene about the incident. Sergeant C. Johnson made note of a single red Honda vehicle parked in the parking lot of BOULEVARD PARK (R1) and it's possible relation to the victim.

It was still during the hours of darkness at that time. The BURLINGTON NORTHERN (R4) train was stopped on the tracks. The crossing guards at the entrance of BOULEVARD PARK (R1) were still activated. I saw the red lights illuminate and alternate and I heard a bell sound ringing. I observed a male, later identified as JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) resting on the railroad track underneath the train some distance to the south of the crossing. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was wearing dark pants but he was shirtless. A white shirt rested underneath the train near him. One white shoe (a right shoe) was located underneath the train some distance to the south of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). A second corresponding white shoe (a left shoe) was not seen in the area.

I took photographs of the crossing area and of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) as he rested in place. I used my department issued Nikon D7500 digital camera with external flash. See photo tab. I then walked a notable distance south to the front of the train. The lower guard on the engine had notable biological spatter on it. I took photographs of the front of the train.

I stood by as BPD traffic officers utilized a scene scanner device on the scene. During that time I walked into BOULEVARD PARK (R1) and examined the red Honda vehicle that Sergeant C. Johnson spoke about. The Honda was parked in one of the furthest south parking stalls close to the entrance. The vehicle was unlocked. I briefly examined the interior of the vehicle, the glove box and the trunk for community caretaking functions in relation to the fatal collision. I did not find anything of evidentiary value.

I searched the area for the corresponding left white shoe and anything else of evidentiary value including alcohol containers or a suicide note. Nothing was located. I utilized a department issued Hilti PD-E laser measure device to measure the distance from the southern tip of the crossing pad to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s resting place. That distance was approximately 31 feet and 5 3/4 inches. The distance from the crossing pad to the front of the train was too great for the laser measurement device. A BURLINGTON NORTHERN (R4) employee utilized a ground wheel measurement device on the railroad tracks from the crossing pad to the front of the train to the south. That distance was provided to me to be approximately 696 feet and 9 inches.

Once the train was moved southbound, I took additional photographs of the scene with

device's scanned image of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s right index finger for an AFIS submission through the FBI database. I received a qualified candidate return in the number 1 position for JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) with a higher score than the other candidates. I conducted a further comparison of the victim's right index fingerprint with JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s known right index finger. I found the two to be in agreement, therefore JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was identified as the victim in this fatal collision. I authored a BPD latent print report and provided it to Evidence and ID Officer DeRuiter for verification. See documents tab.

I was called in at about 0436 hrs to assist with an apparent suicide at BOULEVARD PARK (R1). Sgt. C Johnson informed me a male had laid on the tracks and was run over by a train. CSI Kingery was called in as well.

Kingery and I rode to the scene together. We arrived around 0530. There were a number of BPD Officers and Burlington Northern personnel on scene. Burlington Northern Law Enforcement Officer Dan Sartain was our main contact for that organization.

CSI Kingery assumed responsibility for photography and Traffic Officers Stewart & Wright conducted scene scanning.

As seen in the photographs, the deceased, later identified as JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was a short distance south of the railroad crossing/drive through entrance to BOULEVARD PARK (R1). Information shared with us was that GUILLEN had been laying on the 'pad' of the roadway railroad crossing. GUILLEN's torso was on the pad and his legs were on the rock bed. His entire body was in between the railroad tracks. Later in the investigation, a Burlington Northern Employee shared a still image from the locomotive's camera. In that black and white image a person could be seen laying in between the tracks with their head toward the oncoming train.

In regard to the train, it was traveling south. I tried to find out the train's speed at the time of the incident but Burlington Northern personnel did not have that information available. One person estimated the train was traveling 7-9 mph.

While CSI Kingery took overall photos, I walked the tracks to search for evidence. I marked body parts & tissues with orange spray paint. As seen in the photos, GUILLEN's body was in between the tracks roughly 31 feet south of the crossing. The top of his head had been crushed. His left foot had been amputated and was laying on the bay side of the tracks. The toes to his right foot had also been amputated and were near the body. His right shoe was a short distance further south, laying in between the railroad tracks. The left shoe was never found.

I climbed under the train and tried to find some sort of wallet or ID in the back pockets, but found nothing. CSI Kingery retrieved the Mobile ID unit. I cleaned GUILLEN's fingers and submitted a query but there was with no hit in the 3 databases searched.

While Traffic Officers conducted scene scans, CSI Kingery and I walked the approximate 700 feet to the front of the train. We walked both sides of the track in an effort to find the missing shoe, but it was not located. Also, CSI Kingery photographed evidence/ tissues on the 'cattle guard' at the front of the locomotive.

I notified the Medical Examiner at about 0700. The ME assumed jurisdiction and Dr. Goldfogel contacted TRAVIS PARKE (C1) for the removal.

After the scene scans were finished, I asked BN Officer Sartain to have the train moved to prepare for the removal. Once the train was gone, the scene was examined again. While CSI Kingery was taking detailed photos of the deceased, he noticed a wallet in a front pants pocket. I retrieved the wallet and found an AZ ID bearing the name JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). I took photos of the wallet and contents with my department issued iPhone. They are pictures 136-138. As seen in these photos, the

wallet held no cash and on only a few cards. A debit card also had GUILLEN's name on it.

JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s body was removed some time after 8 am. GUILLEN'S ID went with body.

BFD responded to wash the scene.

Once at the station, CSI Kingery submitted an ABIS query of the index fingerprints obtained at the scene. He received a 'hit' from the FBI. Kingery conducted a side by side comparison and confirmed the deceased was JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). I verified the results and the information was shared with Sgt. Scanlon for Next of Kin notification.

Nothing further at this time.

BWC Activated during interview with HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) when down town

On 09/02/19, I viewed an email that was sent from Sergeant Scanlon to Officer Yoder in which Sergeant Fountain and I were carbon copied. In the email, it asked Officer Yoder to contact Fred Schacht at KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) regarding video for the Train-Pedestrian Collision. The email indicated that the deceased appeared to have been in a fight at KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) sometime prior to the incident at the park. Then, on 09/02/19, I received a phone call from Sergeant Scanlon indicating that family members of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1), the deceased, may be calling me on Tuesday (09/03/19). I advised him that I would refer the family to the Traffic Division since the Traffic Division had investigated the death.

On 09/03/19, I received a phone call from ELESE GUILLEN (C5) which had been forwarded from the Traffic Division. ELESE GUILLEN (C5) indicated that she heard there had been a fight near KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) and she thought that it was suspicious. ELESE GUILLEN (C5) said that a relative had seen a picture that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) either sent or posted on social media at 0200 hours on 08/31/19. The venue appeared to have a comedy club background. Since then, it appeared that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s facebook account had been deleted. I told ELESE GUILLEN (C5) that an officer had already been assigned to collect the video from KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) but that I had not seen the video. I told her that a detective had not been assigned yet, and I provided her with my desk phone number as a point of contact.

I received a voicemail from HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) on 09/03/19, and he indicated that he had questions about whether or not video had been located of the fight. I reviewed Longarm and found that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had spoken with Sergeant Scanlon earlier and was the one who originally advised of the fight near KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5). I phoned HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) and learned the following from him: --The fight had occurred around 0230 or 0300 hours. --JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had no vehicle, and they had taken a taxi to get down town.

--They had been at KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) and then gotten pizza at PYE HOLE (R7). The fight occurred near a gray building across the street. --The fight was JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) and HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) versus about eight people. --JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) just walked off from the fight and never looked back, and he headed toward Boundary Bay Brewery. --HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) walked across the street to get one of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s shoes, and then HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) walked toward Boundary Bay Brewery to try to find JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). He eventually took a taxi back to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s apartment believing that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) may have gone back there, but JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) did not answer. --They had left HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4)'s residence at about 2000 hours the previous evening, gone to the Kulshan K2 Brewery and had a few drinks there, and then had taken a cab to down town. --HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) estimated that they had consumed about four drinks throughout the evening. --HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had been trying to get JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) some pizza at PYE HOLE (R7) because JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was intoxicated. --HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) believed that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was a marijuana user but did not use other drugs. He did not believe that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had

used marijuana that night.

At the end of the call, HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) agreed to me picking him up the next morning and driving him to the area where the fight occurred so that he could point out specific locations.

On 09/04/19, Detective McGinty and I picked up HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) from his apartment and drove him to the intersection of Railroad Avenue and E Chestnut Street. We exited the vehicle, and I advised HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) that an audio and video recording would be occurring, and then I activated my body worn camera. (The following is a summary of what HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) told Detective McGinty and me. Please see BWC footage for exact verbiage.) HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) confirmed that they had been drinking at the KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5), and we also determined that the second bar that they had been drinking at down town was CAP HANSENS TAVERN (R6). He said that they went back and forth between the two bars several times that night. They had taken a taxi from K2 and it had dropped them off in front of the Herald building. After the bars closed, there was a big line at PYE HOLE (R7) and they were getting pizza. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) seemed upset and said 'those guys over there are talking trash to me.' HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) said he did not hear the group of guys saying anything to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had gotten his slice of pizza and had started eating it, but JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) didn't want the slice that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had gotten for him. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) then started across the street towards the group, and HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) followed him. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) pointed out the location where the fight had occurred, and it was near the sculpture on the northeast corner of the intersection near JUST POKE (R9). JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) and HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) started talking to the guys, and HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) was trying to tell the other group that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was just drunk. There was a tall white male with an afro that seemed to be the main guy having a problem with JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1). JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) and the male with the afro then ended up fighting, and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) ended up on the ground in front of JUST POKE (R9). JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) then suddenly got up and walked away down the street. Several of the guys from the fight walked away northbound on Railroad Avenue (not the same direction as JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)). One of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s shoes had come off during the fight, and one of the males had thrown it across the street. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) walked across the street to grab the shoe, and when he walked back, an uninvolved male then walked up to HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) and handed him both HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4)'s phone and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s phone. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) said that he then checked around the block yelling for JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1), and when he couldn't find him, he took a cab back to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s residence.

Detective McGinty and I then dropped off HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) at his work site at Sehome High School. He was working for a construction company that was finishing up the high school building/grounds project.

Officer Yoder later located video of the fight on the City of Bellingham Avigilon system. Detective McGinty and I watched the fight. The fight was very much as how HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had explained it, but there were fewer subjects involved than what HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had estimated. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was seen taking the first swing during the fight. His attempted punch missed badly, so it appeared to me that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) must have been moderately to heavily intoxicated. At one point during the fight, JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) walked away from the group southbound and then westbound down toward Cornwall Avenue. It appeared that he stopped at least once to turn around and possibly yell or gesture back toward the group, but he did not return and eventually walked out of the view of the camera.

I later leaned that Officer Yoder was able to locate several additional sources of video which showed JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) walking/running southbound on Cornwall Avenue south of E Chestnut Street. At no time did it appear that anyone was following JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) on foot or by vehicle. The most likely route

JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) would have traveled to get to the train tracks at the entrance to BOULEVARD PARK (R1) would have been along the railroad tracks after having accessed them near or before the intersection of Cornwall Avenue and Pine Street. From there, it would have been extremely unlikely that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) could have come across anyone who was involved in the fight prior to him being located on the railroad tracks at the entrance to BOULEVARD PARK (R1).

Detective McGinty made contact with JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s family and advised them of our findings. At this time, there is no reason to believe that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s death was the result of any foul play. In addition, Investigator deRuiter attended the autopsy of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s body, and nothing to suggest foul play was immediately identified at that time.

On 09-05-19 KARINDA WOODS (C7) came into the Bellingham Police Department to speak with me. KARINDA WOODS (C7) is the soon to be ex-wife of HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4). She had questions as to the incident that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) was involved in. They have a common child together and KARINDA WOODS (C7) was wanting to make sure that it was safe to send the child with HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) as they had scheduled parenting times.

KARINDA WOODS (C7) explained that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had contacted her and gave her a very simple statement about the incident at first and then over the next few following days, his story became more evolved and was giving more details and some of them seemed outlandish to her. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had detailed to her how he and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had been down town drinking and that they had gotten into a fight, with what he said was 8 other people, and how JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) lost a shoe, and he had JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s phone, so that's why police contacted him, and that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) later got hit by a train and died.

Everything that KARINDA WOODS (C7) said that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had told her, he had already told us. I told KARINDA WOODS (C7) that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had been extremely cooperative with us (police) and that his statement had been verified through surveillance footage. I asked if there were any other reasons, other than this incident, for which she thought she should question HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) parenting; she said no. KARINDA WOODS (C7) seemed to be relieved by knowing that there did not seem to be any foul play concerning HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) or the incident.

On 09-06-19 I, Detective McGinty along with Sergeant Johnson, met with HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4). We had requested that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) physically walk around downtown and show us where the events of the fight had taken place. While driving towards downtown, the following was learned from conversation with HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4): HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) currently works for Carson Steel and JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) worked for at "Gundies".

We drove to the corner of Railroad Avenue and E Chestnut Drive where we then walked around on foot. The following was learned from HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4): He, JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1), and one of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s friends that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) did not know, started drinking together at KULSHAN BREWING COMPANY (R8) around 8 o'clock in the evening. Around two hours later, they caught a cab with the company that has "blue vans" and were dropped off on E Chestnut Drive in front of the Herald Building. They then went between CAP HANSENS TAVERN (R6) and KOMBUCHA TOWN (R5) drinking beers at both places.

HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) told us that around 0300 hours, they were standing at the corner of Railroad Avenue and E Chestnut Drive when they were approached by, according to HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4), eight male subjects. Later, video evidence confirmed that it was only five male subjects. A confrontation ensued between JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) and the male subject that was white, tall, thin build, with an afro style hair. When the confrontation became physical, everyone started fighting. The fight ended up in front of JUST POKE (R9) where JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) ended up on the ground, and he lost a shoe. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was able to get up and he then left walking west on E Chestnut Drive, with one shoe on. This was the last time that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) saw JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1).

HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) added that the tall white male with the afro, picked up the shoe that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) lost and threw it towards the west side of Railroad Avenue. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) walked around for a while looking for and calling out for JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) but he never found him. A younger guy came up to him and handed him his cell phone, as well as JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s cell phone. He said that he must have lost them in the fight. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) also added that it was little weird since JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had actually lost his phone earlier in the night, but it could have very well been that he had both phones in his pocket. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) then went to JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1)'s house to check on him but he wasn't there either. HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) was to keep his son in the morning, so he went back to his apartment to go to sleep.

Later, watching video footage from the city cameras located at the corner of Railroad Avenue and E Chestnut Drive, HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4)'s statement was confirmed. It all aligned everything that HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4) had stated. Even later so, the medical examiner, GARY GOLDFOGEL (C6) came to the department and viewed the video footage also. He stated that he wanted to see the video from the train also. Officer John Courtney outlined the surveillance footage in detail in his report.

On 09-09-19 CSI de Ruiter spoke with me and requested the information for the contact at Burlington Northern Railway, so that he could arrange GARY GOLDFOGEL (C6) being able to view the video. I gave him the contact of Greg Beam, in the claims department at number 425-330-1852.

On 09-09-19 I met with DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) along with three of his family members, at the Bellingham Police Department. DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) is the brother of JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) and was wanting an update on the investigation. He had questions as to the fight that JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had gotten in on the night of the accident.

I told DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) that we (police) had spoken with HAMILTON BITTRICK (C4), who was with his brother that night and that we had viewed the video footage of the entire fight. JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) was never was unconscious and he was not followed by anyone when he left walking/jogging.

I told DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) that the medical examiner was planning on conducting the autopsy this afternoon or first thing in the morning and that he would know more. The female that was with DANIEL GUILLEN (R3) was ELESE GUILLEN (C5). She asked what trauma JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1) had been through. I had to ask her to elaborate and she said that the receptionist at the medical examiner's office told her, in regards to planning services for JONATHAN GUILLEN (V1), to consider a closed casket, because of all of the trauma he went through. I informed her that most likely what she was doing was trying to find a really nice way to say that he was hit by a train, so plan on a closed casket funeral. 


