TO ALL PARTIES:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) initiated a special proceeding in the above-referenced docket to determine if Paul Henrickson d/b/a Concrete and More (Concrete and More) is engaged in business as a solid waste collection carrier without possessing the certificate required for such operations.

On October 11, 2019, the Commission entered Order 01, Order Instituting Special Proceeding; Complaint Seeking to Impose Penalties; and Notice of Mandatory Appearance at Hearing. On the same date, the Commission issued a *Subpoena and Subpoena Duces Tecum For Production of Documents* (Subpoenas) to Concrete and More commanding Paul Henrickson to appear before the Commission at a special proceeding scheduled to convene at 9 a.m. on November 26, 2019.

On October 22, 2019, this case was reassigned to Administrative Law Judge Rayne Pearson.¹ Judge Pearson is unavailable to preside on November 26, 2019.
