Pursuant to WAC 480-109-110(1)(h) and condition (3)(e) in Appendix A of Order 01 in Docket UE-171087, (hereinafter referred to as “condition”, or “requirements”) Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) submits the attached conservation service tariff sheet revisions.

The purpose of this filing is to update the budgets and terminations dates in electric Schedule 83 and to remove language from Section 9 Special Conditions referencing the time period of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019. PSE also revised Schedules 83, 251, 258, and 262 to remove language including end-uses which promote Fuel Conversion and Fuel Switching.

PSE also revised Schedule 201 (Low Income Weatherization) to update the name of the Washington State Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Plan to Washington State Low-Income Weatherization Manual and added reference to the Washington State Low-Income Weatherization Manual as a standard per WAC 408-109-100(10)(a).

PSE also hereby submits proposed electric Schedule 219. This Energy Efficiency initiative is designed to bring value to all PSE customers by collaborating with PSE's Systems Planning group to identify localized conservation and demand response potential, develop plans to achieve a defined percentage of that potential, then implement those plans to deliver identified energy efficiency and capacity savings.

The Targeted DSM program uses avoided costs for a specific municipality to calculate the cost-effectiveness of conservation measures. This allows PSE to offer rebates and incentives to PSE customers in these locations that are higher than those in its broader service territory. These rebates and incentives are available only during the duration of the specific Non-Wired Alternative ("NWA") Project, as determined by PSE, either through a bonus amount attached to the incentive, or additional, separate incentives.

Consistent with WAC 480-109-110(1)(h) and condition (3)(e), PSE reviewed the proposed Conservation tariff revisions with the CRAG on October 1, 2019. PSE received no comments or suggestions for revision changes.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect the original issue date of November 1, 2019, and effective date of January 1, 2020. As required by WAC 480-90-193, PSE will post the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site coincident with the date of this transmittal letter.
