Subject: Waste Management of Greater Wenatchee, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 14

Enclosed are the revised pages 2, 23 and 24 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity credit for residential customers receiving subscription recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect a change in the initial recycling credit from <\$1.50> to <\$0.19> per month for residential customers. We are requesting that these tariff revisions go into effect on February 1, 2020.

This change is jointly due to the change in commodity values, tonnages and materials composition since the commodity credit adjustment on February 1, 2019. Furthermore, with this filing we are requesting a continuation of the current practice of estimating the projected revenues based on the revenues received over the most recent 6 months. Due to the continued volatility of the markets, we believe that this practice is the most reasonable expectation of what the commodity values will be over the next 12 months.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Customers will be notified of the change in their recycling credit adjustment on their next regularly scheduled billing after approval by the Commission. In addition, the counties have been notified of these proposed tariff changes.
