NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE COMPETITIVELY CLASSIFIED TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY REGISTRATION AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has determined that your company has failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay required regulatory fees.

Under WAC 480-120-382, every competitively classified telecommunications company must file an annual report and pay the required regulatory fee by May 1 of each year.

WAC 480-121-060 provides that the Commission may revoke the registration of a competitively classified telecommunications company if that company fails to file its annual report or pay required regulatory fees. Staff has determined that, as of the date of this notice, each of the above-named companies has not filed a complete annual report, paid the regulatory fees that were due by May 1, 2019, or both.

To avoid revocation of your registration, you must take one of the following two actions **within 30 days** of the date of this notice:

- (1) **Come into compliance** with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual report and by paying the required regulatory fee (annual report forms as well as information on how to make a payment are available on the Commission's website: <u>www.utc.wa.gov</u>); or
- (2) **Request a hearing** to demonstrate why your registration should not be revoked. All hearing requests must comply with the Commission's procedural rules, contained in WAC 480-07, which are available on the Commission's website on its Legal Research Tools page.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days of the service date of this notice by complying with the regulatory requirements or by requesting a hearing, the Commission will enter an order revoking your telecommunications company registration without further notice. Companies without the required telecommunications company registration from the Commission are prohibited from providing Commission-regulated telecommunications services in the state of Washington.
