RE: Tariff Submittal, Tariff Number 3, Waste Connections of Washington, Inc. G-253, Roll Off Disposal Increase

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Our company has been notified by the Clark County Public Health Department that the solid waste tip fee at all Clark County transfer sites is by \$.09 per ton, effective January 31, 2020. At this time, we are only requesting to increase the Item 230 pass-through rate from the current \$84.04 to \$84.13. We project this will increase revenue for drop box service by \$2,400 (0.11%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 300 drop box customers affected by this change. The last general rate increase approved by the Commission was effective January 1, 2018.

Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates.

We respectfully ask that this filing be accepted under LSN, per WAC 480-70-276. If the LSN is accepted and these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the rates will become effective on bills rendered on or after January 31, 2020. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
