Per a phone conversation on March 5, 2021, with Theresa Campbell of the Yakima County Coroner Office at (509) 574-1610, the cause and manner of death of Amos Yemowat Ryan Palmer on December 28, 2019 at 0228 hours when struck by BNSF Railway Co. train at milepost 78.2, in Wapato, Yakima County were as follows:

Cause of death: Severe body trauma, struck by railroad train

Manner of death: Accident
