Summary of Violation:

Neighborhood Fence put in a locate ticket on 7/29/19, 19325869 at 22751 Appleway in Liberty Lake that was not valid to work until 8/1/19 which is 2 full business days. The fence crew started digging for post holes on 7/31/19 prior to Avista's locator arriving to locate. **Attachment #1** vicinity map and area of conflict and **Attachment #2** is copy of the locate ticket.

On August 5, 2019 Avista's inspector stopped at the job site because the ticket was flagged as a high consequence ticket due to a high pressure pipeline in the area of the locate ticket and found that the posts were installed and concreted over the top of Avista's 6" steel high pressure pipeline that was operating at 160 psig. Avista's inspector found in talking with the fencing crew that they started work on July 31, 2019 augering all the posts for the fencing. Which was confirmed by the locator, when he showed up late in the afternoon on July 31st the post holes had already been augered. **See Attachment #3** for locator's ticket comments and **see Attachments #5 – #8** for locator's pictures.

Neighborhood Fence augered directly over Avista's pipeline to install a fence post without having waited the 2 full business days for locate marks. One of the posts was installed within feet of a pipeline marker and should have been a clue to stop and wait for locates **see photo in Attachment #4**. Neighborhood Fence came close enough to the depth of the pipeline to get into the bedding sand on top of the pipeline. Luckily there was no damage done to the pipe; however, if the auger had hit the 160 psig pipeline, there could have been serious consequences.

Avista's concern is that if there was damage done to the pipe, we may not have found out about it until a leak developed if Avista's inspector had not stumbled upon them while still working. This property is being developed as a large RV Park. **Attachment #1** – Vicinity map of location of alleged violation, red circle indicates area of conflict with fence and pipeline
