Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 9, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity price adjustment (CPA).

For Pierce County Refuse the CPA will increase from a debit of \$1.92 to a debit of \$2.15 (12%) per residential customer per month. This change affects approximately 54,000 customers in Pierce County.

For residential customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord the CPA will increase from a debit of \$1.68 to a debit of \$1.84 (9%) per unit per month. This change affects approximately 4,900 customers on Joint Base Lewis-McChord.

Recycling commodity markets appear to have stabilized. We are no longer requesting a waiver from WAC 480-70-351(2). The calculation uses the most recent six-month historical period to estimate the recycling commodity expense/commodity adjustment. The true-up is also based on the most recent six months data. The true up is then divided by a 12-month customer count because the commodity price adjustment will be adjusted again effective March 1, 2021.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity credit will go into effect on March 1, 2020. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revised rates.
