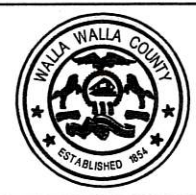

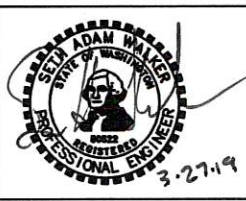


PORT KELLEY RD RAILROAD CROSSING		SHEET

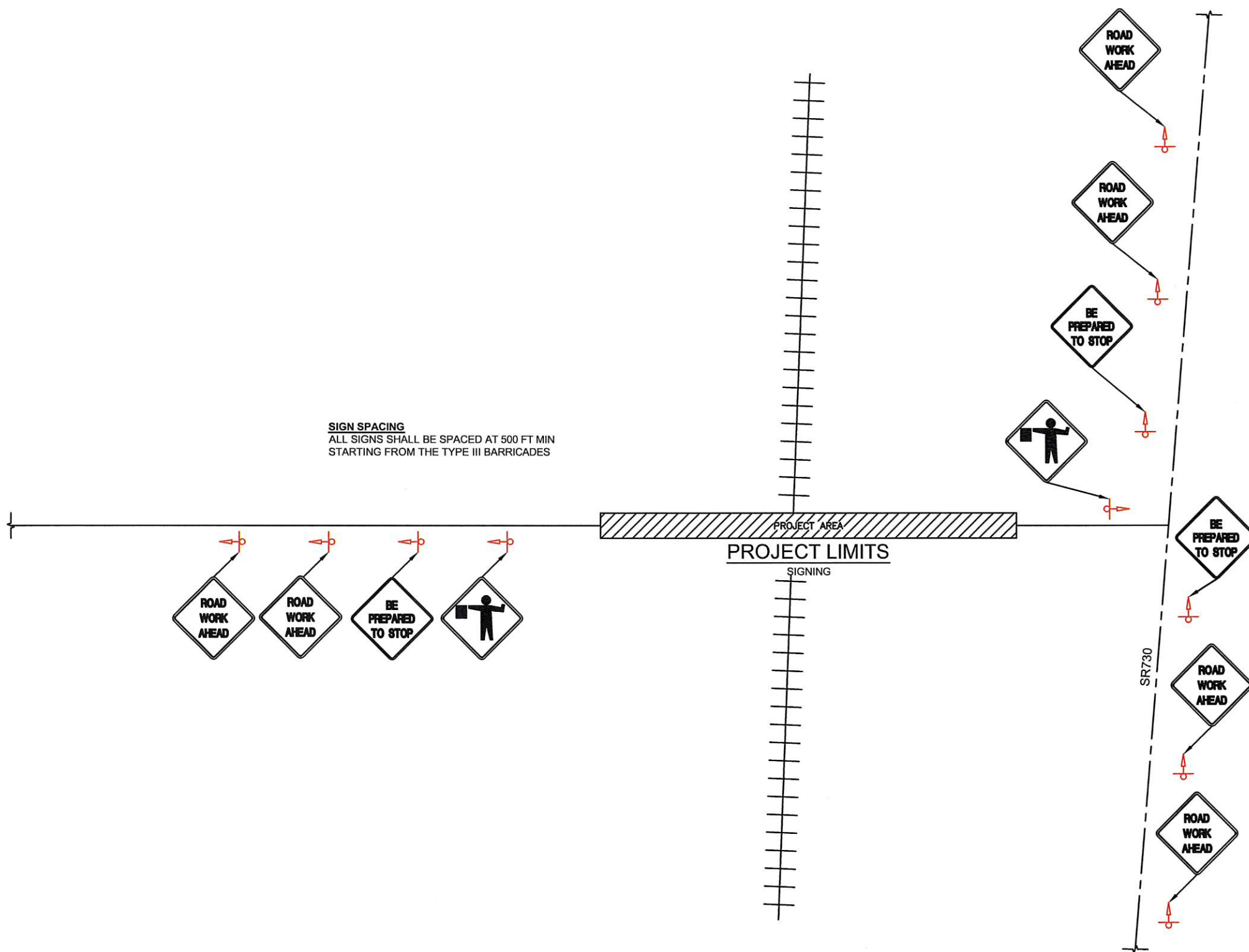

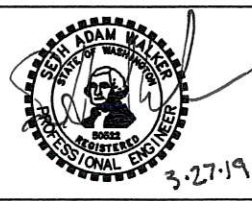

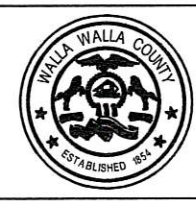
