A \$1.00 increase in the residential flat individual line rate on August 7, 2020 will result in an increase in the Tribal Lifeline credit amount. That credit provides additional lifeline support of up to \$25.00 in addition to the baseline Federal Lifeline support for qualifying tribal lands subscribers.

For future administrative efficiency, this filing revises footnotes associated with various USOCs and removes exchange specific amounts which were previously included in the tariff for internal reference. That internal reference material will be located in the company's Exchange and Network Services Catalog as of the effective date of this filing.
