Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 13, for Columbia River Disposal, Inc., G-51

Our Company was notified that during the 2020 legislative session the state legislature increased the B&O tax from 1.5% to 1.75% effective April 1, 2020. With this filing, we respectfully request the Commission approve a rate increase to pass this increase through to customers.

The increase is proposed as follows: Residential service \$100, .29%; commercial service \$120, .29%; and roll-off service \$15, .29%. There are approximately 150 residential; 40 commercial; and 2 roll-off customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase approved by The Commission for Columbia River Disposal, Inc. became effective April 1, 2018.

Attached are the proposed tariff pages containing the increased rates, as well as supporting documentation for those changes. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they are intended to become effective on September 1, 2020.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
