Narrative:

On July 30th 2020 at 0800 hours, I was dispatched to the report of a person hit by a train at the junction of Old Pacific Hwy Se and Saint Clair Station Rd Se in Olympia WA. I responded, and arrived on scene at 0823. Deputy Russell and Deputy North had arrived before me, and instructed the railway to stop traffic along the tracks.

Deputy Russell referred me to the witness who had seen the incident from the site on which he was working, Tracy A Rowland DOB: 08/08/1977. Tracy told me he and his labor crew had showed up to complete work at Saint Clair Station that morning, and upon arriving Tracy had seen a white male (identified in this report as John Doe) standing by the NE side of the tracks from the station. Tracy yelled at John to get away from the tracks as the train was coming. Tracy says John looked back at him, then got on the tracks and started walking. Tracy went to his truck, and using his radio warned the train operators directly to stop the train as there was someone on the tracks.

After interviewing Tracy, I contacted the conductor (Nelson D Beers DOB 08//23/1962) and engineer (Mark D Ranney DOB 12/06/1962) at the front of the train, which was roughly ¼ mile past the station. The train operators told me they had put the brakes on the train as soon as Tracy had warned them and it began to slow. However, they informed me that the train can take up to 1 mile to stop dependent on speed, and they were still at speed when they sighted John on the tracks roughly 150 feet in front of them. Nelson told me he saw John, "walking towards him with a big smile on his face, or maybe just gritting his teeth". The train impacted the male, and the operators continued to brake until they came to a stop roughly ¼ mile past the impact point. I asked both operators for a recorded statement, but they both declined. They stated they did have a forward

facing camera on the train, and their manager could retrieve it upon arrival later. Detectives handled the acquisition of the video.

I then assisted detectives M. Hamilton, T. English, and M. Brannon with the documentation and cleanup of the scene. There was a 250 ft spread between the proposed impact point with the subjects body, and the final piece of biological debris. The main portion of his body was still under the train, roughly 100ft past the initial impact point. On the east side of the train, was the subjects detached left and right arm, as well as various smaller fragments of his body. On the west side of the train was the subjects right foot. Upon our arrival at the scene of his body, the subject John Doe was declared deceased by medic Taylor.

Coroner Traci Mccullah arrived on scene, and I assisted her in recovering the body. We moved under the train, and pulled the body out, placing it in a black bag, which we then placed on a body sled, and pulled down the tracks to her vehicle. The train was then asked to move, and they proceeded down the tracks to the SW, clearing the area. We then collected the other biological evidence, to include the arms, foot, and various other fragments found throughout the 250 ft debris field. The coroners case number is 20-1501-07.

This concluded my involvement in this case.
