Enclosed is a copy of the contract between Mr. and Mrs. Torre and Washington Water Service Company (WWSC) to extend the existing water main line in 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue NW and installation of any other facilities needed to provide water utility service. This site is on parcel # 0222163017 in Pierce County, which is serviced by Peacock Hill Water System, DOH ID #66637Q. This agreement has been signed by Louis C. Torre and countersigned by Matthew D. Brown, the General Manager of WWSC.

Estimated costs identified on Attachment C are \$20,286.00. Washington Water will provide an engineered construction plan and will allow the parcel owner to hire his/her own underground contractor to install the water main, appurtenances and service for the intended propose of installing water service to the parcel listed above. To this extent, a full payment of \$20,286.00 has been received, as attached.

Upon completion and certification of the extension, Louis C. Torre will provide to WWSC a Bill of Sale which will transfer ownership of the facilities to the company.
