During this incident an Officer wearing an assigned body worn camera was present. Footage from that camera will be uploaded to the department digital evidence management system.

On 10/08/20, about 1624 hours, officers and I were dispatched to S 212 St and 77 Ave S in the City of Kent/County of King, regarding a Sounder train versus pedestrian accident.

Upon arrival, I was flagged down by BNSF employees on the north side of S 212 St. The Sounder train was to the south of S 212 St, on the eastern track. I walked south to the BNSF employees, where I observed a male laying obviously deceased on the east side of the east track. The male had a large head wound exposing his brain, and was missing his left arm below the elbow. Puget Sound Fire arrived on scene and confirmed the male was deceased.

I then walked to the train and spoke with Engineer James Kvam. James informed me the train was traveling southbound with two locomotives and seven cars. The extra locomotive made the train longer and heavier than a regular Sounder train. The lead locomotive was #911. James observed the male on the track ahead of him, with most of his body on the east side of the track. The male's head and left arm were resting on the left rail from the perspective of the train. James applied warning signals, and the male lifted his head, but rested it back on the track. Therefore, James knew that the male was conscious laying on the tracks.

James activated the emergency braking system, but was traveling 79mph at the time. The train struck the male before the train had began to slow, and was therefore traveling 79mph at time of collision.

Officer Bateman conducted an AFIS inquiry for the male, which identified him as Daniel James Jack. Daniel's identity was also confirmed via his WADOL photo.

Investigator Porras-Foye with the King County Medical Examiner's Office (KCMEO) arrived and took possession of Daniel. The KCMEO case number is 20-3110.

All photos were uploaded into a secure digital evidence manager.

It appeared Daniel intentionally placed himself on the track. There is no indication of a crime at this time.

Further information obtained will be documented in a supplemental report.

Per a phone conversation on February 25, 2021, with Administrative Staff, Namele Kekuewa, of the King County Medical Examiner's Office, at (206) 731-3232, ext. 4, the cause and manner of death of Daniel James Jack on October 8, 2020 at 1619 hours when struck by Sounder Commuter Rail train at milepost 14.2, in Kent, King County were as follows:

#### Cause of death: Suicide

Manner of death: Multiple blunt force injuries; decedent laid down across the tracks in front of the train
