This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA), dated July 8, 2021 for the "FRA report of a rail vs. pedestrian fatality accident on Sept. 25, 2020, when a BNSF freight train struck a trespasser near railroad milepost 97.1 in Bellingham, WA (possibly near Central Ave.)."

I was dispatched to a train vs pedestrian accident on ROEDER AV near CENTRAL AV. I was advised that BNSF had called 911 to report a train hitting a pedestrian who was on the tracks near this location. I responded along with several other patrol units in addition to the fire department.

It was still a bit dark upon arrival, and the train was stopped. The engines were facing north and stopped just past the C ST crossing. Officers and fire department personal began looking for a possible victim. One was eventually located under the train cars on the bridge that spans between CENTRAL AV and C ST. She was later identified as SHANNON SMITH (V1), and it was an obvious DOA.

Her body had been cut in half just below the rib cage. A purse was found nearby and a wallet contained her Washington State ID. This information was passed along to SGT JAMES for next of kin notification.

I worked along with INV ASPESSI for the remainder of the investigation.

I proceeded up to the engine to speak with the train engineer. He was identified as JACOB HODGINS (W1). The conductor was identified as EDWARD BUTLER (W2).

I spoke with JACOB HODGINS (W1) first.

He explained he works as an engineer for BNSF. He has held this position for the past 5 years. I asked about the train he was currently operating and he gave me the following information. This is train number HLYDVBT125. The lead engine is BNSF 8090. It has 3 engines attached, but only the lead engine was operating. He has 98 railway cars attached.

This train originated in EVERETT WA and is enroute to VANCOUVER BC.

JACOB HODGINS (W1) and EDWARD BUTLER (W2) both started their day on this train. JACOB HODGINS (W1) said he got a normal amount of sleep last night and does not have any illness. He said he is alert and feeling normal. He said he entered into Bellingham at 30 mph and was maintaining this speed per regulations.

He was north bound and approaching the CENTRAL AV crossing sounding his horn as required. He saw the crossing arms down and flashing as normal. He said he first saw SHANNON SMITH (V1) standing on the metal walkway grating that parallels the track. This is above the water of where Whatcom Creek dumps into Bellingham Bay. She was on the east side of the tracks and staring at the train. He said he began sounding the horn repeatedly to get her attention. He said he kept sounding the horn as the train closed distance, and this is when SHANNON SMITH (V1) stepped in front of the train without warning. When this occurred, he hit the emergency brakes, and came to his current stopped position.

After the train stopped, EDWARD BUTLER (W2) got out to check the welfare of SHANNON SMITH (V1), but quickly realized there was nothing he could do. They radioed their dispatch to advise what occurred, and this is who called our 911.

I confirmed this account with EDWARD BUTLER (W2). He also said he got a normal amount of sleep last night and feels alert and normal.

While doing this investigation, I spoke with BNSF employee GREG BEAM (C6). He

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advised me that the crossing arms at C ST were actually down and audibly sounding even before the train crossed the CENTRAL AV crossing. This means that SHANNON SMITH (V1) was on the bridge with audible and visual warnings on each side of her activated and sounding. Also during this time, I heard the lead engine sound it's horn confirming it is functioning as normal.

Working with INV ASPESSI, it was determined that Point of Impact between the train and SHANNON SMITH (V1) occurred approximately halfway across the bridge. This Point of Impact was determined to be were one of SHANNON SMITH (V1) shoes was located between the tracks. I believed this to be a valid location based on training I have received and accidents I have investigated as a Traffic Reconstructionist.

I inspected the front of the train, and did not see any obvious evidence of where exactly along the front made contact with her. However, blood splatter and body matter was found on the second axle back from the front, on the right side. Walking rearward from this location did not show any other obvious signs of contact.

In addition to her body being cut in half, one of her arms was cut off around the elbow area. Her head was intact but did show a large laceration on her forehead. Her shirt was on, but her lower torso was missing clothing. She was wearing women's underwear. Both shoes were missing from her feet.

Walking rearward from her body, several personal items were located. These were items such as hand sanitizer and small containers that were presumably in her purse.

While continuing this investigation, I met with BNSF Detective TYLER NIES (C5). He also introduced me to BRENT OSTLUND (C4), who works for BNSF Claims. BRENT OSTLUND (C4) advised he will be able to show video from the accident in the next few days after their investigation takes place.

TRAVIS PARKE (C3) with the medical examiners office arrived during this time. I assisted him in collecting and placing SHANNON SMITH (V1) into a body bag for further examination by GARY GOLDFOGEL (C1).

At approximately 1000 hrs, the train was able to be moved. Once moved, we walked the tracks again looking for any more evidence other that needed to be documented. None was located.

On 0639 hrs I was on uniformed patrol in a marked police vehicle and was dispatched to a call of train versus pedestrian at 699 ROEDER AVE. Dispatch indicated that this call was made by PEDRO ESCOBAR (R1). OFC MEDLEN was at the scene as primary and CSI OFC L.ASPESSI was there to take photos of the scene. BELLINGHAM FIRE DEPARTMENT was also on scene. BELLINGHAM FIRE DEPARTMENT reference case is BF20-13331.

I arrived on scene at 0645 hrs. OFC MEDLEN asked me to make contact with the train's engineer. I met with JACOB HODGINS (W1) at the front of the train. JACOB HODGINS (W1) indicated that he was the engineer of the 8090/ES44C4 train that was traveling northbound from Everett, WA to Vancouver, Canada. He reported that as he was passing the CENTRAL AVE. bridge he began to blow the train whistle for the upcoming railroad crossing at C ST. JACOB HODGINS (W1) noted that after passing the CENTRAL AVE. bridge that he saw the victim on the walkway bridge on the eastside of the train tracks. JACOB HODGINS (W1) stated the victim looked at him and he began to honk the horn loudly. He reported the victim then jumped in front of the train. JACOB HODGINS (W1) reported that he pulled the emergency brake right after the train made contact with the victim. JACOB HODGINS (W1) indicated that train was traveling at 30 MPH when it made contact with the victim. JACOB HODGINS (W1) reported that he has been an engineer for five years. He also reported he had slept for five hours the previous night, which is reportedly normal for him, and that this travel from Everett, WA to Vancouver, Canada was his first travel of the day. JACOB HODGINS (W1) reported his train sign is HLYDVBT125 and that the train he was operating at the time of the accident has three engines and 98 cars.

On scene I observed the victim's body laying under the train near the walkway bridge on the eastside of the tracks. The victim appeared to be wearing a purple top and underwear; however, no pants or shoes were seen. I saw a black purse several feet south of the body on the outside of the tracks on the eastside. At the front of the train I observed blood and possible body matter on the second and third axle.

OFC MEDLEN will make contact with BNSF to retrieve video footage of the incident.

SERGEANT D.JAMES made a next of kin notification.

On 9/25/20, I responded to the Roeder Ave. bridge between Central Ave. and C Street for the report of a pedestrian struck by a train. Both the railway crossing at Central Ave. and C Street were activated, blinking and making an audible signal noise upon arrival. The train had headlights illuminated on the engine car and the train whistle was operational. The bridge where SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S body was located had clearly marked NO TRESPASSING signs posted on either end of the metal walkway.

Traffic Officer Medlen, Ofc. Brewer and I searched the area for the body. Fire department personnel located the victim, later identified by her WA stated driver's license as SHANNON SMITH (V1), approximately 20 feet from the west end of the bridge. SHANNON SMITH (V1) had been cut in half by the train, with her upper torso and head lying on the north side of the tracks and the lower portion of the body lying between the tracks underneath the railcar. SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S right arm was severed and visible under the train, east of her torso. SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S lower torso was clothed only in underwear. SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S black sweat pants and white tube socks were later underneath the train wheels and appeared to have been ripped off after she was impacted. SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S upper torso was clothed in a purple sweatshirt.

Approximately halfway between C Street and Central Ave along the tracks, a black purse was recovered that contained SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S identification, medication, SSN card, insurance cards, some bills and miscellaneous personal effects. A few feet further east, two white tennis shoes were located underneath the train. No other debris or personal items were located beyond the white tennis shoes. It was believed that the tennis shoe location was likely the point of impact with the train. The location was marked with orange spray paint, along with the location of SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S body.

Officer Brewer advised he observed a hospital wrist band bearing SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S name near the black purse. The wrist band was not recovered and believed to have been blown off the railroad bridge into the water below. On SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S body, a green wrist band was observed on her still intact left arm bearing the date "9/24/20." Sgt. James confirmed that SHANNON SMITH (V1) had been admitted to ST JOSEPH HOSPITAL (R3) on 9/24/20 due to [Deleted as per 70.02.005.4 & 78].

GARY GOLDFOGEL (C1) with the WHATCOM COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINERS OFFICE (R2) was contacted. GARY GOLDFOGEL (C1) advised he would take jurisdiction and have TRAVIS PARKE (C3) respond to collect the body. GARY GOLDFOGEL (C1) advised that he needed a copy of the train surveillance footage urgently. BNSF RAILWAY POLICE (R4) and insurance investigators advised they would be in contact with GARY GOLDFOGEL (C1) and arrange for him to view the footage. Traffic Ofc. Medlen would also be following up with BNSF RAILWAY POLICE (R4) to obtain a copy of the surveillance footage.

An examination of the engine car showed that SHANNON SMITH (V1) may have walked between the first two wheels of the train when she was struck, rather than striking it head-on. No blood or debris were observed on the front of the train, however, there were a few points on the passenger side of the engine car that appeared to be potential impact points. Photos were taken showing the bloody areas on the outside of the train.

Once the train was moved down the tracks, a secondary search was completed of the railroad tracks along the bridge. No items were found beyond the location of the white tennis shoe. A set of keys and a key chain were located on the tracks, along

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with a pair of torn black sweat pants and two white socks. The shoes, keys, torn black sweat pants and white socks were collected by TRAVIS PARKE (C3) and added to the body bag sent to the WHATCOM COUNTY MEDICAL EXAMINERS OFFICE (R2). TRAVIS PARKE (C3) was also given SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S WA state identification card.

I transported SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S purse to the police station to photograph and impound the contents. Inside SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S purse, I located a list of medications, dosage and frequency taken. Photographs of the list were taken using my department issued NIKON D7500 digital camera. A pill organizer was also located inside the purse. Here is a list of medication and pills located inside SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S purse:

All loose pills were packaged together to be destroyed after photographs were taken.

Also located in the purse were two lighters, which were photographed then discarded due to flammability. A zippo lighter that was collected at the scene near the purse was engraved with initials "GMS". The zippo lighter did not appear to be functional. The zippo lighter was kept with the purse an impounded for safe keeping.

It is unknown if SHANNON SMITH (V1) was a smoker, consumed alcohol or used any recreational drugs.

A check of Longarm contacts with SHANNON SMITH (V1) showed that she was spoken to on 9/22/2020 regarding concerns that someone was poisoning her water and messing with her cable and internet. Inside SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S purse were a recent cable bill and power bill. There were also four mental health related contacts in 2015 which mentioned [Deleted as per 70.02.005.4~&~78] , paranoid thoughts and suicidal thoughts about jumping from the I-5 overpass.

Besides the mental health contacts, SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S personal health concerns are unknown. None of the medications located inside her purse were in a pill bottle. It is unknown who was SHANNON SMITH (V1)'S primary care physician.
