CenturyLink QC will continue providing this service to existing customers, allowing a Private Switch/MLTS customer to send ANI information to an E911 Control Office to provide site or station location information for an E911 call, will continue to be provided to existing customers. Existing customers are therefore not impacted by this filing.
