

Dear Mr. Johnson:

The purpose of this filing is to correct the language in the Washington Exchange Carrier Association's tariff to be sure that the proper rate is used for 8YY traffic. It turns out that surprisingly at least one of the WECA intrastate rates is lower the corresponding NECA interstate rate. Therefore, to avoid any inadvertent increase in charges to carriers providing 8YY service, this tariff change is needed.

Because the purpose of the tariff change is to preserve existing rates and not make a change in rates, statutory notice is not required. WAC 480-80-123. As a result, this filing is on one day's notice.
