Dear Mr. Young,

So far this year, the City of Richland has annexed three areas:

- 1. The Zinsli Annexation area, Ordinance No. 50-20, approved on January 2, 2021
- 2. The Allenwhite Annexation area, Ordinance No. 11-21, approved on May 18, 2021
- 3. And the Badger Mountain Winery Annexation area, Ordinance No. 12-21, also approved on May 18, 2021

Copies of the corresponding ordinances are attached.

The City understands that there are overlapping WUTC certificates for solid waste collection within that area: G-110, held by Ed's Disposal, Inc., G-118, held by Basin Disposal, Inc., and G-237, held by Waste Management of Washington.

Consistent with RCW 35.13.280, the City gives notice to the WUTC of its decision to contract for solid waste collection or provide solid waste collection itself pursuant to RCW 81.77.020. Solid waste collection services will continue to be provided in the annexation area by contract with authorized rates corresponding to WUTC-approved tariff rates for services subject to the G-certificate.
