ICV and BWV were activated to this incident.

On 03/20/2021 I was working uniformed patrol with Officer JEROME #7474 as 3N11. At 2214 hours we responded to 1520 NW Carkeek Park RD. The initial information from dispatch stated, "GO WITH FIRE, MALE WAS STRUCK BY TRAIN AT LOC"

Upon arrival I and other officers observed a train stopped on the tracks below Carkeek Park with one of its operators, later identified as witness/Joseph W JAEGER, standing beside the train. We proceeded to the operator's location. While approaching we observed several clothing items along the tracks. Near the train operator we discovered subject/1(1) laying underneath the train between the tracks. I(1) was visibly breathing with visible injuries, as much of his clothing had been removed. Injuries included bruising and abrasions throughout body and active bleeding through his nose and ears.

The train involved with the incident was Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad (BNSF) #7676E C SCMRBC 077 F. The train was headed northbound on the west tracks. The front of the train stood approximately ¼ mile north of 1(1) 11 11 11.

Multiple Fire Engines arrived on scene including M31, M44, L8, E24, E35, B4, B6, A25. SFD personnel transported (1) from the train tracks to a Medical Unit. While continuing the investigation I was informed by dispatch that (1) was pronounced dead by Fire on scene

I spoke with witness JAEGER who stated the following: He and the conductor were operating the train at approximately 2235 when they observed an individual ahead standing on the water side of the tracks. As the train was about to pass the individual, he jumped onto the tracks in front of the train. They were moving at approximately 20mph at the time of the incident. The conductor later identified as witness/Mihn X CAO was still in the front train car occupying the engine room.

I spoke with CAO and he stated the following: He was operating the train and he witnessed a subject jump in front of the train as it passed by. He jumped from the westside (water side) onto the train tracks shortly before it reached him. CAO honked the horn repeatedly to notify the subject of the trains approach.

I and backing officers then searched under the train for additional belongings or evidence and located a cell phone, headphones, and misc. clothing items near (1) location.

Additional information gathered on scene was from the BNSF Officer Dunnes on scene, who informed me that at 2147 hours BNSF Police received a notification of a male "playing chicken" with trains.

The incident took place at Scenic Subdivision milepost 10.169.

I contacted Medical Examiners who took possession of 1(1) body on scene. Thy provided me with KCME #21-0870.

We accompanied KCME Brian Peterson to the residence where they verified the identity of 1(1) and and provided a death notification.

All property gathered on scene was taken into KCME custody.

Officer Young took photos of the scene and uploaded them to evidence via Axon Capture.

Sgt BELFIORE screened this incident on scene.

This incident was also screened with Lt Garth Green and the Duty Captain.




Age of decedent: 16 years old

Cause of death: Multiple blunt force injuries to the head


Manner of death: Suicide
