RE: Commodity Adjustment for Tariff Number 10, Certificate Number G-98, City Sanitary, Joe's Refuse, White Pass Garbage

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Attached please find revised pages for Tariff Number 10, as well as supporting documentation for the commodity adjustment. Tariff pages 1, 23, 23A, 25, 25A, 28, 28A, 29 and 29A are affected by this change.

In area RSA-1 the residential and multi-family adjustment will change from a debit of \$1.51 to a credit of (\$.55), a change of (\$2.06) (136.4%) per customer, per month. There are approximately 10,800 customers affected by this change.

In Thurston County Below 142<sup>nd</sup> the residential adjustment will change from a debit \$1.68 to a credit of (\$.58), a change of (\$2.26) (134.5%) per customer, per month. There are approximately 4,500 customers affected by this change. The multi-family adjustment will change from a debit \$1.67 to a credit of (\$.57), a change of (\$2.24) (134%) per customer, per month. There are approximately 290 customers affected by this change.

If approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the revised commodity adjustment will go into effect on January 1, 2022.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(vi), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
