Dear Ms. Maxwell,

Sprint Communications Company L.P. (“Sprint”) respectfully provides notice to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (“Commission”) that it intends to cease providing basic local exchange service as a competitive carrier and interexchange services in Washington and wishes the Commission to cancel these registrations as permitted under WAC 480-120-083(d).

In Docket No. UT-97104, by Commission Order issued on July 9, 1997, the Commission approved Sprint’s application to amend its registration authority to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications service. The Commission previously authorized Sprint to provide interexchange services on September 30, 1986 by Commission Order issued in Docket No. U-86-79.

Sprint no longer has customers receiving any basic local service or interexchange services requiring a certificate. Accordingly, there are no customers to be notified regarding this request, and cancellation of Sprint Communications’ certificate will have no adverse consequences for consumers in Washington.
