

Actions:

On the above date, time and location, I was working as a Patrol Officer for the City of Marysville. I was wearing a department issued uniform complete with patches and badge. I was driving a fully marked patrol car complete with decals, emergency lights and siren.

I responded to a train vs. pedestrian collision at State Ave. and 92nd St. NE. in Marysville, WA. 98270. The exact location given to dispatch was 9114 State Ave. Marysville, which is Pilchuck Rentals, which is the building the victim ended up behind on the tracks.

I arrived in the area at approximately 1135 hours and saw the train stopped at 88th St. NE. and State Ave, facing south-bound and blocking the RR crossing at 88th St. NE.

I was flagged over by several people at 92nd St. NE. to the west of State Ave. I turned into 92nd St. driveway just north of Pilchuck Rentals and drove to behind the buildings.

I contacted a witness, Scott A. Meyers DOB 12/25/1992, near the railroad crossing at 92nd St. NE. who stated he called 911. Meyers appeared to be in a state of shock and asked me if he got everything off of him, indicating the incident occurred in front of him and parts of the victim ended up on him.

I looked Meyers over and saw a small piece of what appeared to be bone with blood on it on his face. I asked Meyers what happened.

Meyers stated he went on his break and went behind the building to smoke a cigar. He saw a young

male sitting on the tracks, eating, and then he saw the train coming and yelled to the person on the tracks in warning but it was too late and the train hit the male and Meyers got blood splatter on him and body parts were everywhere.

Meyers appeared visibly ill from seeing this incident. I asked where the male was now and he pointed due south, to just behind Pilchuck Rentals.

I saw a bag and some belongings at the RR crossing at 92nd St. NE. where the witnesses stated the male had been sitting, eating.

I walked south to the tracks and saw two legs that appeared cut off at or just below the knees and then I saw the male lying on the tracks, in-between the two tracks, face down with his head pointing south and arms stretched out in front of him. The male appeared to have had trauma to his head.

The male was shirt-less and his hair was a faded reddish color, an outgrown spiky hair cut, approximately 1-1 ½' long, with hair sticking straight out from his head. The stature of the male appeared short and the feet on the legs were relatively small, appearing consistent with those of a short adult male.

I recognized this hair as looking like that of Kevin S. Adams DOB 2/1/1993, a young man of small build, whom we frequently have contact with, wandering the streets of Marysville, often appearing high, drunk, or mentally unstable, often trespassing and appearing generally homeless, and getting 911 called on him. I knew of Adams however that he did have family living in the area and would sometimes stay with them.

I then spoke to another witness, Ora C. Kopp DOB 2/24/1957. Kopp had been standing by the dumpsters behind the BBQ joint just north of 92nd St. NE. also butting up to the tracks. Kopp stated he had seen the male, a young adult male, possibly late teens, on the tracks acting high on drugs for the past half hour and sitting on the tracks eating and drinking.

Kopp stated he was still standing by the dumpsters when he saw the train coming. Kopp remembered about the male on the tracks and thought "oh sh.." and looked to the south where the male had been sitting, but by that time the train had already hit the male and all he saw was body parts scattered when he came closer.

In the meantime other officers arrived on scene.

I got statement forms to all the witnesses standing around, which included a Pilchuck Rentals employee, Dominic Ochoa Bustos Andres DOB 1/4/1998, who stated he had warned the male earlier

not to sit on the tracks because it wasn't safe, but the male had ignored him. Thirty minutes later Andres saw the train coming and then saw body parts everywhere.

Another witness was the train conductor, who had made his way to our location, Kevin H. Allred DOB 7/8/1963. Allred stated he honked the train horn several times in about the 9700 block. Then he saw what appeared like a garbage bag on the tracks when the engine was at about the pole that was located right next to the tracks (east side), approx. 250-300 ft north of 92nd St.

At about 200 ft distance Allred stood up to get a better look and realized it was a male lying on his back between the two tracks, with his head pointed south, his hands behind his head, and his legs dangling sort of diagonally over the east rail, and he was located right next to (north of) the wooden planks stretched between the tracks at the 92nd St. RR crossing.

Allred immediately active the emergency brake of the train but was not able to get the train stopped in time.

Yet another witness was Jeff Knoch DOB 11/19/1960, the owner of the BBQ joint Jeff's Texas style BBQ located at 9214 State Ave.

Knoch stated he was answering the phone inside his BBQ joint when he heard the train blaring its horn and the wheels squealing, with brakes locked.

Knoch stated normally the southbound trains don't blare their horns for this long this far north before reaching 88th St.

Knoch stated his back door was open but he was not aware of anything going on outside other than what he heard from the train until after police and fire arrived.

After getting statements filled out I took another look at the body and mentioned to Officer Taylor that the male looked like Kevin Adams. Officer Taylor confirmed to me that he also recognized the male as Kevin Adams and that he believed it was indeed Adams.

I then made contact with an employee at Pilchuck Rentals who stated they captured the collision on their video system. I went with him to their office and saw the video footage.

The impact occurred at time stamp 1032 hours on the system, with their system being off by one hour, so the actual time would have been 1132 hours. I saw, who I believed to be Adams, at the bottom right of the screen apparently lying down on the tracks, at 1132 hours the train appeared from the right side of the screen, hit Adams and sent some of his belongings and parts of him flying to the side in a

southern direction. The video then showed the train coming to a stop and Adams lying under the tracks approximately 50 ft south from his original location.

I asked one of the BNSF employees what mile marker the 92nd St. crossing was for the tracks and he stated "40.6".

Detective Sgt. Maples and Detective McShane arrived on scene.

In the meantime Officer Sale had taken initial photos of the scene and then went to the front of the train to take more pictures and to contact the conductor and get a photo of his conductor's badge.

I called the Medical Examiner Chelsea Warneke and she stated she could be here in about 11 minutes.

Det. McShane started FARO scanning the scene and I left the scene for a break.

When I returned I started working on my Sector collision report and M.E. Warneke was ready to have the train move.

The train cleared out of the area and Adams' body was placed into the M.E.'s van.

The fire department was called out to wash down the tracks.

I started looking for information for next of kin for Adams. Det. Vinson told me of an incident when Adam's mother called in looking for Adams, thinking he may have died in the cold.

Dispatch was able to locate the incident showing the caller as Lori Z. Adams DOB 8/25/1968 living at 7014 65th St. NE. in Marysville, WA. 98270.

Officer McKenna Chaplain Dan and I went to the address to contact Lori Adams.

Simon Adams DOB 10/12/1990, Kevin's brother, answered the door and we asked if his mother was home. Lori then came out and she asked us if we were there because of something Kevin had done.

Chaplain Dan told Lori that we had some bad news about Kevin and Lori became very concerned, saying she just saw him yesterday and he was fine.

We explained that Kevin had been involved in a collision with a train. Lori was in shock and asked if that was why the train was blocking 88th St. around noon for several hours.

We told Lori and Simon in as plain a version as possible what happened and then allowed them to ask

questions for details, which we then tried to explain in as gentle a manner as possible.

Lori asked how we were sure it was Kevin and she started pulling out her phone showing us pictures of his tattoos

I told Lori that many of us officers knew Kevin and recognized him. Lori then showed me pictures of a tattoo on Kevin's left forearm of a wide solid band of black, as well as a tattoo on his back.

I compared the tattoo with a picture I took of Adams at the scene, just to make double sure. The tattoo on the forearm was a good match. The tattoo on the back was not clear enough on the photos to make out what they were.

I asked Lori if Kevin lived here and she stated he stayed here 2-3 times a week over night, the rest of the time he was out and about and staying at "Tanner's" house and "Andy's" house, unknown last names, and Kevin refused to show Lori where they lived.

Simon stated Kevin left the house on Thursday 5/6/2021 and he hasn't seen him since.

Lori stated she was at Babushka's on State Ave yesterday (5/7/2021) around noon and saw Kevin walking by the store. Lori went outside to talk to Kevin and she asked him if he would come home tonight. Kevin told her "yeah, maybe". Lori asked Kevin if he was ok and he told her he was ok. Kevin then left towards Alfie's.

Lori stated she's been trying to help him get off the drugs and he had planned to go to a court date in June and then go to rehab after that.


Simon stated he could tell last time he was home that he's still using drugs.

Lori was concerned and sad, and sad that Kevin didn't have a chance to change his life before meeting God, but she understood that Kevin's life style was destructive. Although shocked and sad, she was not too surprised.

The Chaplain stayed behind and provided the family some paperwork and support.

After leaving the Adams' residence I called the M.E. and told her that the family had been notified and gave her the contact information, as well as pictures Lori had sent to my phone for identification purposes. The M.E. told me that she had submitted Kevin's finger prints and already received a response with positive identification that the decedent was indeed Kevin Adams.

I then worked on completing the collision report.

On 5-8-2021 at approximately 1134 hours Officers were dispatched to a train versus pedestrian accident in the 9100 block of State Ave. I arrived on scene. I walked down 92nd ST towards the tracks. I observed body parts all over the gravel east of the train. I observed what appeared to be severed legs just south of my location on the rocks to the east of the train.

I contacted the Streets department to start shutting down the roadways, as the train was blocking the 88th ST crossing.

Once Detectives arrived I obtained crime scene tape. Officer Taylor and I taped off areas to the north, then the south of the collision location. As I was walking back I could see a partial body still underneath the train.

After finishing with traffic control I cleared the call.

Assignment:

I (Detective McShane) was assigned to the Marysville Police Department Investigations Division using radio call sign (8114) on the above date and time inside the City limits of Marysville Snohomish County, Washington.

Narrative:

On 05/08/2021 I was called out at about 1150 hours for a Train vs Pedestrian collision.

On my way to the scene I went to the PD and picked up the FARO 3D Forensic Scanner and equipment. I then continued to the scene and arrived at 1226 hours.

I was advised by Sgt. Pitts and Maples, a witness had seen the male laying on the tracks and he attempted to get him off the tracks but did not get to him in time. I did a quick walk of the scene where I observed several legs on the east side of the RR tracks at 92nd ST. I could see the deceased under the train.

I started to forensically map out the scene with the FARO 3D Scanner. I took scans on both sides of the train around the body and location where the deceased was laying. I could see some food wrappers on the ground.

Officer Vinson was taking photos and Officer Rusch was getting statements from the witnesses.

I was advised Scott Meyers had gone behind the building to have a cigar when he noticed the deceased sitting on the tracks eating. When he heard the train he yelled at the male, but it was too late and the train struck the pedestrian. Officer Rusch noticed there was blood spatter on Meyers and he was shaken up. She also observed the body parts laying behind the business.

Witness Ora C. Kopp stated he had been standing behind the BBQ joint at 92nd and State Ave when he saw the pedestrian acting "high on drugs" for the past half hour sitting on the tracks. When Kopp heard the train, he remember the person sitting on the tracks and went to check but said it was too late.

Several other witness stated they heard the train, but did not see anything. A few others stated the saw him sitting

on the tracks earlier.

After I scanned the impact area, I went to the front of the train and scanned the front of the train.

After clearing the scene, I was handed the thumb drive provided by Pilchuck Rentals which showed the incident. I copied the file and put it in the Detective Folder. I made a copy for evidence, which was given to Officer Rusch who booked it into evidence. I also provided her the raw data from the FARO which she booked into evidence if needed later.

6/3/2021

I met up with BNSF Manager Greg Beam at his office in Everett. He allowed me to review the train video of the incident.

Upon reviewing the video it was set to be about 116th and State Ave. After a few seconds I noticed the landmarks of about 100th and State Ave. From the view of the train, you can see something on the tracks but cannot see what it is. When the train got to the switching shack it started to use the horn. After the horn went off there was no movement from the person on the tracks. When the engineer started to brake, there was still no movement from the Adams when the train struck him.

It was very hard to see where the witnesses were standing from the video on the train.

I later had Officer McKenna go out with his Lidar and measure the distance from the Shack which I could see in the video. It was 1,265 feet from the point of impact.

ASSIGNMENT

I, Detective D. Vinson, am a fully commissioned Police Officer assigned to the Marysville Police Department, Investigations Division. On the above date and time my assignment was as a Detective.

INVESTIGATION

On 05/08/21, at about 1150 hours, I received a call from Sgt Maples requesting I respond to a fatality collision involving a train and a pedestrian. The collision took place in the 9100 block of State Ave.

When I arrived on scene, I saw the train had been traveling south bound and the front of the train was stopped a little south of 88th St NE. The end of the train to the north was out of might sight. I met with Officer Taylor and Officer Zaretzke in the driveway located to the west of the intersection of State Ave and 92nd St NE. The driveway continues over the railroad tracks to the west and there is a stop sign at the railroad tracks.

Officer Taylor told me the deceased had been tentatively identified as Kevin Adams. He pointed out the point of impact which was on the north side of the driveway. He also pointed out two detached legs and told me the main portion of the torso was under the train a couple of train cars to the south. I was told a witness had seen Kevin laying on the railroad tracks and had yelled at him to move prior to being struck. I provided crime scene tape to the officers and requested they tape off the area.

I know Kevin Adams from multiple prior contacts. He had mental health and substance abuse challenges. He primarily lived on the streets but his mother was able and willing to give me support. On 12/13/20 Kevin's mother, Lori Adams, had called 911 concerned that Kevin might have died in the cold weather. I had seen Kevin 12/12/20 and knew he was still living on the streets. He was known to often sleep in dumpsters and I had warned him of the dangers of sleeping in dumpsters. I called and spoke to Lori who speaks limited English. Kevin's brother helped translate during the conversation. She indicated Kevin refuses to stay at her residence and accept help. I recommended they contact a Snohomish County Designated Crisis Responder to seek assistance with Kevin. I also provided her contact information for Officer Buell who works with the embedded social worker program.

I was assigned to take photographs of the scene and evidence. I photographed the scene including areas of the train

that I saw had contact with the deceased. I entered the cab of the train engine which was still occupied by the conductor and engineer. I took photographs of the controls and gauges including the red emergency brake lever which was up in the engaged position. I found multiple booking photos of Kevin's tattoos and was able to confirm his identity by matching the tattoos.

Officer McKenna and I collected Kevin's shoes, shirt and coat. We picked up and disposed of food and garbage that was near the point of impact. When the train was moved, I noted that the heard the train whistle confirming it was working. After the train was moved, I took additional photos of the impact area.

I later burned the photos onto a DVD. I logged the photos and clothing into evidence.

I drive a fully marked Marysville Police Department Patrol vehicle equipped with emergency lights, siren and decals.

Actions: On 05/08/21, at approximately 1133 hours, I heard a call come out over the radio for a collision in the 9100 block of State. The call was updated to report it was a train pedestrian collision. It was further updated that there were body parts strewn about. I went in route to the call and on approach, noted that train main front car had stopped just south of the intersection at 88th St NE, blocking the intersection there. I continued north to the Pilchuck Rental address noted above. Several persons were out in front of the business and flagged me toward the location on the north side of the building there.

Officer Rusch had already arrived ahead of me. I went toward the railroad tracks there and noted on approach to the area several pieces of body tissue on the ground ranging from a few feet to several feet away from the track. I began to notice blood spatter indicating a south direction of impact. I tracked the blood spatter back to a location that I believed was the impact area on the north side of the drive/pass over crossing to a few houses on the west side of the tracks.

I walked further south and noticed what appeared to be a severed piece of leg, having a foot and lower calf area. I then noted a similar piece of leg further south and slightly farther away from the tracks. I then noticed the torso of a male inside the tracks under one of the rail cars. I walked closer to it and recognized the body size and red hair color to be consistent with a subject I know from around town as Kevin Adams. Officer Sale additionally had approached from the south and arrived at that point around the same time and stated he recognized the tattoo on the arm as being that of Adams.

I then began to set up some administrative duties. Officer Zaretzke assisted in contacting city streets to get street closed signs out. I began calling detectives to try and get a collision investigation team in route. I was not able to get a hold of Det. Sgt. Maples but then Officer Zaretzke informed me he had gotten ahold of him and was calling out detectives. I then began to attempt command notification. I left messages for Commander Lamoureux, Commander Vermeulen, and Commander Akau. I was able to

make contact with Commander Wade and advised her of the situation. Commander Vermeulen then called me back and advised he had spoken with Commander Wade.

I then began to assign additional tasks. I requested Officer Sale take photographs of the incident with his work phone. I asked that Officer Taylor remain initially as sight security and Officer Rusch to begin collecting witness statements. There was a witness identified as an employee at Pilchuck Rentals who was taking a work break and was near the incident when it happened. A chaplain was requested to assist him as he was visibly upset over seeing the incident happen. I remained on scene until Det Sgt Maples arrived with other collision investigators. I cleared the scene sometime later.

Actions: On 5/8/2021 at approximately 1134 hours, I responded to 9114 State Avenue in Marysville, Washington on the report of a train versus a pedestrian. I arrived on scene at the 8800 Block of State Avenue where I observed the BNSF train stopped and facing southbound. The BNSF train was blocking 88th Street westbound and eastbound. I traveled on the west side of the train tracks around the train northbound with Officer Taylor #0182 who arrived on scene shortly before I did.

Upon traveling northbound on the west side of the tracks, we approached the rear area of Pilchuk Rentals. Upon climbing onto the train and going across it, to the east side of the tracks, I observed flesh and body parts scattered in the gravel area behind Pilchuk Rentals. I observed two lower portion legs in the gravel area. I observed small pieces of flesh scattered all through the rear area of Pilchuk Rentals. I began taking photographs of the scene with my department issued phone. I took photographs of the overall scene and the scattered body parts. I also observed shoes and a beer can in the gravel area behind Pilchuk Rentals. Lastly, I observed food and other personal items directly next to the tracks directly north of 40th Drive NE, which leads behind Pilchuk Rentals. I walked along the tracks a short distance and observed a male lying underneath one of the black colored train cars. The male was lying face down, his legs completely gone, and his head split open. I recognized the male from previous encounters as Kevin Adams.

I began assisting Officer Rusch #0077 by taking photographs of the initial scene, the train, and body parts, prior to detectives arriving.

I called for a chaplain per the request of multiple witnesses who were on scene who had observed what happened and who were visibly distraught.

Afterwards, I responded to the front area of the train to take additional photographs. I took additional photographs at the front area of the train. I observed blood underneath the train on the east side of the tracks. I also observed small pieces of flesh underneath the train on the east side. I took photographs of everything that I located related to the collision.

I spoke with Ronald (Engineer) and Kevin (Conductor) while I was on scene. I obtained contact information for both and later provided it to Detective Maples. I took photographs of Kevin and Ronald's BNSF badges. I spoke with the Ronald and Kevin prior to Detective Maples' arrival on scene. Kevin advised me that he did not see the male on the tracks as he was laying on the roadway/driveway area that went across the tracks in a perpendicular direction. He advised me that once about 100 yards away, he observed that it there appeared to be someone or something on the tracks. He advised me that he activated the red emergency brake for the train but that it did not stop in time due to the wait of the train and stopping distance required. Ronald and Kevin told me that the train was approximately 4,000 feet long. I took photographs of the red emergency brake inside the train which Kevin advised me was currently in the activated position.

While on scene, a male named Trevor Sandvig DOB 2/7/1999 (425) 923 9153 contacted me and stated that he saw the male seated on the tracks before the incident occurred. Trevor told me that he did not see the impact that occurred, just the male on the tracks seated. He was in a hurry to head home and was unable to provide me with a written statement. I advised him that detectives may contact him in the future for more information.

Afterwards, I responded to the police department where I uploaded all of the initial photographs I took on scene. I uploaded the photographs onto the P Drive once at the police department.

This concluded my involvement in this incident.






