
Dear Ms. Maxwell:

Attached for filing you will find the above referenced tariff sheet. The purpose of this filing is to combine the Service Order charge and the Line Connection charge into one charge called the Installation Charge. The rates will go from \$16.00 to \$25.00 and will result in a revenue increase of \$54.00 per year. The reason for the increase is an increase in labor costs since the service was originally tarified.

A second purpose is to clarify that the NSF charge applies to any type of payment that is not honored or is declined. The Company is charged a fee by the bank when this occurs. The customer causing the charge should be responsible for it.

This applies to the Silverton Exchange.
