RE: Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1329 Tariff update to include page 11.1.

Dear Ms. Maxwell,

I am filing an update to the existing tariff for Basin Water Sources, Inc. to include page 11.1 to meet the requirements of the new Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1329. The effective date is July 28, 2023.

In accordance with Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1329 (ESHB 1329) Basin Water Sources, Inc will not disconnect any residential customer (including residents of metered apartment buildings and mobile homes) for nonpayment when the National Weather Service has issued, or has announced it intends to issue a heat-related alert such as an excessive heat warning, a heat advisory, an excessive heat watch, or similar alert for the area in which the residential user's address is located.

In the event a customer has been disconnected for non-payment prior to any heat-related warning issued by the National Weather Service, the customer may request reconnection of water service during the period in which the weather-related alert is active or is scheduled to be active. Water companies must include specific language on all customer disconnection notices about how to request water service reconnection if a heat alert occurs while service is disconnected.
