Governing Provisions

ITEM
NO.

1. ADULT FARES:

Adult fares apply to passengers who have reached or passed their sixteenth birthday.

2. YOUTH FARES:

Children under two years of age are carried free and must be accompanied by an adult. Youth fares apply to passengers between the ages of two and sixteen.

3. SENIOR AND MILITARY FARES:

Senior and military fares apply to passengers who have: a) reached or passed their sixtieth birthday, or b) are currently on active duty or retired from a career in the United States armed forces, or c) are dependents of military personnel and can show military identification.

4. INTERMEDIATE APPLICATION:

Fares to or from intermediate points not named herein, will be the same as the fare to or from the next more distant station for which fares are named herein.

5. OPERATING RIGHTS:

Rates and provisions named in this tariff, or as amended, are limited in their application on intrastate commerce to the extent of the operating right as set forth in Permit No. C-000933.

6. ROUND TRIP FARES: (C)

Will receive a discount from the price of two one way fares, rounded up to the next dollar.

7. TICKET REDEMPTION:

Unless otherwise noted below, unused tickets or portions thereof will be redeemed when presented by lawful owner within one year from date of sale. Unused portion of one way or round trip tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used and refunding the balance of the purchase price.

7.1 There is no charge to reschedule a reservation prior to the trip's departure. A customer who has made a reservation but fails to cancel, reschedule or appear at the designated pick-up point by the scheduled departure time is not eligible for a refund unless the failure was caused by an airline delay or cancellation.

8. GROUP RATES:

When four or more passengers travel together a 10% discount off the total fare is provided

9. FREQUENT TRAVELLER RATES: (C)

Passengers may purchase \$460 of ticket credit for \$400. The value of these tickets will be deposited on account and the value may be used to purchase tickets for up to 5 years from purchase date.

10. HOME PICKUP / DROPOFF: (C)

Home pickup / drop-off service may be offered to passengers in Whatcom County prior to the start or following the end of a regularly scheduled airporter run in which the passengers will be riding.

11. NORMAL, EXCESS AND OVERSIZED BAGGAGE: (C)

Two normal sized baggage plus a small carry on, are allowed per adult, senior or youth fare.
There is a minimum \$15.00 charge for each bag over the 2 normal size/weight bags per person limit.

Normal baggage means under 50 lbs. and under 70” of combined height, width and length
Normal baggage means suitcases, golf clubs, gun cases, skis and snowboards that fit within the weight and dimension limits described above.
Normal baggage does not include boxes, surfboards or bicycles for which there is a \$15 additional fee
Bicycles must be packaged in an Airline approved carrier

Previous arrangements must be made with the office during office hours, for oversized (not normal) boxes, trunks, and cartons.

12. BAGGAGE LIABILITY: (C)

As provided by Washington state law (RCW 81.29.050), unless higher value is declared prior to transportation and agreed to in writing by Airporter Shuttle, property damage liability will be limited to \$100 for ALL items.
Additional valuation will be charged at \$5 per \$100 or fraction thereof.

13. HOLIDAY CLOSURES:

The offices will be closed and no airporter or bus service provided on Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.

14. PREPAID RESERVATIONS:

Prepaid reservations guarantee seat availability.

15. CANCELLATIONS: (C)

A \$8 processing fee will be charged for canceling prepaid reservations that are refunded to electronic payment.
A \$15 processing fee will be charged for canceling prepaid reservations that are refunded to a check.

16. INTERCOUNTY TRANSPORTATION

Prepaid reservations are required to guarantee transportation

17. UNACCOMPANIED MINORS

The parents of all minors (youth fare) that are travelling unaccompanied must sign and agree to the terms and conditions of WIC’s unaccompanied minor release form. Terms: WIC requires parents to provide the contact phone numbers for the guardian that will be meeting the minor. WIC specifically takes no responsibility for a minor once we have arrived at the destination and the minor exits our vehicle.

18. Animals. (C)

Service animals are defined as dogs that provide assistance to a disabled passenger will be carried free of charge. Service animals may not occupy a seat. They must be at the foot of their owner.

Other animals will be transported only when they are in pet carriers. At no time may the pet or carrier occupy a seat. Pet owners will be responsible for any extra cleaning/sanitizing of the vehicle that may be necessary because of their pet.

Pets in small lap sized carriers than can be stored at the foot of their owner may be allowed on the bus. These pets must remain in their small lap sized carrier throughout the trip.

Pets in small lap sized carriers will be charged \$10
Pets in other carriers will be charged \$20

WIC recommends hard sided pet carriers and takes NO responsibility for pets transported in soft sided carriers or for the emotional distress a pet may feel while in luggage storage areas.
