NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL CERTIFICATION  
AS A SOLID WASTE COMPANY  
AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING

**Re: Docket TG-230835**  
Vanderveen Family Transport, Inc.

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has determined that your company has failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay required regulatory fees.

Under WAC 480-70-071(1), every solid waste company must file an annual safety report each year by May 1. In addition, under WAC 480-70-076, solid waste companies must pay regulatory fees each year by May 1.

WAC 480-70-071(1)(d) provides that the Commission may cancel the certificate of a solid waste company that fails to file its annual report, and WAC 480-70-076(5) provides that the Commission may cancel the certificate of a solid waste company that fails to pay required regulatory fees. Staff has determined that, as of the date of this notice, the above-named company has not filed a complete annual report or paid the regulatory fees that were due by May 1, 2023, or has done neither.

The Commission, therefore, intends to cancel your company's certificate.

To avoid cancellation of your certificate, you must take one of the following two actions **within 30 days** of the date of this notice:

- (1) Come into compliance with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual safety report and paying the required regulatory fee (annual report forms as well as information on how to make a payment are available on the Commission's website: [www.utc.wa.gov](http://www.utc.wa.gov)); or

- (2) Request a hearing to demonstrate why your certificate should not be canceled. All hearing requests must comply with the Commission's procedural rules, contained in WAC 480-07, which are available on the Commission's website on its [Legal Research Tools](#) page.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days of the service date of this notice by complying with the regulatory requirements or by requesting a hearing, the Commission will enter an order canceling your certificate without further notice. Companies without the required passenger carrier certificate from the Commission are prohibited from providing charter and excursion services in the state of Washington.
