These revised tariff pages include the addition of a new service as well as the correction of the disposal large charge at Spokane County Transfer Stations that was incorrectly reversed in our most recent filing. The new service is for 96-gallon bear resistant carts. We are seeing an increase in requests for these services across Washington and found it prudent to add to our Spokane County tariffed area.
