Notice of Intent to Establish a Railroad Quiet Zone by Public Authority

Notice is hereby provided that the City of Marysville, Washington intends to create a NEW 24-HOUR QUIET ZONE (QZ) in accordance with the regulatory provisions contained in Title 49 CFR 222.39(b)(1) and Appendices A and B to Part 222. As required by the Federal Railroad Administration under 49 CFR 222.43, the following information is provided to you and other parties.

Affected Highway Rail Crossings - 49 CFR 222.43(b)(2)(i)

The following twelve (12) affected public highway grade crossings and seven (7) private crossings within the proposed new Quiet Zone. All crossings are under the jurisdiction of the City of Marysville, within a 7.4 mile corridor.
