Pursuant to RCW 70.95.212 please accept this letter as 75 day notification of disposal rate adjustment.

New disposal rates becoming **effective January 1, 2025**, are as follows:

1. A 7% increase for solid waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. Disposal fee for solid waste at the Waste to Energy Facility is going from \$132.62 per ton to \$141.90 per ton. The minimum fee for solid waste is increasing from \$21.67 to \$23.19.
2. A 7% increase for clean green yard waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal of clean green is going from \$66.88 per ton to \$71.56 per ton. The minimum fee for clean green is increasing from \$7.12 to \$7.62.
3. A 7% increase for waste delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility which the director determines requires special handling. Disposal fee for special handling waste is going from \$238.37 per ton to \$255.06 per ton. The minimum fee for waste requiring special handling is increasing from \$119.17 to \$127.51.
4. A 7% increase for waste tires delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal fee is going from \$172.83 per ton to \$184.93 per ton. The minimum fee for waste tires is increasing from \$25.88 to \$27.69.
