Re: Review Committee Decision – Complaint Case 24-096 Avista Utilities vs. M&L Construction, Inc.

Dear Mr. Killip:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee (committee) received a complaint filed by Avista Utilities against M&L Construction, Inc. (M&L Construction) regarding potential violations of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030.

On Dec. 5, 2024, the committee formed a peer review board and reviewed Complaint Case 24-096.

The peer review board determined that the respondent, M&L Construction violated RCW 19.122.040(2)(a) one time for not using reasonable care to avoid damaging underground facilities; by failing to determine the precise location of underground facilities which have been marked.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$1,000 be assessed to the respondent as follows:

• \$1,000 for one violation of RCW 19.122.040(2)(a) that occurred on June 11, 2024, at 11811 N Stevens Ct, Spokane, WA.

Additionally, the committee recommends a deferral opportunity be offered to suspend \$800 of the \$1,000 total, based on the condition that M&L Construction incurs no additional violations of RCW 19.122 within the next 12 months.
