Republic Services appreciates the opportunity to work with you and your team on your CDL project in Whatcom County

- Construction demolition and land clearing debris (CDL)

Republic services can accept the debris provided the material is properly represented on a profile. All material must meet Republic Services acceptance criteria through our profiling process. Each load must be accompanied by a completed and signed manifest / bill of lading and or waste information sheet which includes an assigned profile number.

Disposal Rates 20 ft. Containers*:

- 1 Debris in 20ft containers (47 cubic yard) and chassis supplied by RDC will be charged at a rate of \$2225.00 minimum charge per container based on 25 tons of material per container. Tonnage over 25 tons will be charged at a rate of \$89.00 per ton.

Disposal Rates 48 ft. Containers*:

- 2 Debris in 48ft containers (107 cubic yard) and chassis supplied by RDC will be charged at a rate of \$2375.00 minimum charge per container based on 25 tons of material per container. Tonnage over 25 tons will be charged at a rate of \$95.00 per ton. Max 30 tons

- *Above rates are good thru December 2025*
- Payment terms net 30-day.
- Material must meet Washington State Department of Ecology regulations for "Non-Dangerous" Wastes in order to be approved.
- Documentation: Prior to delivery of material, RDC requires that an authorized individual execute all documentation on behalf of the client. Documentation shall include a master service agreement along with a bill of lading or waste information sheet or both.
- Material loading: Customer is responsible
- In addition, customer shall be responsible to load all containers within legal weight limits for over the road transport.
