PASSENGER RULES

(C)*Animals: Service animals are allowed, as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act, and will be carried free of charge. Service animals may not occupy passenger seats but may lay or stand at the feet of the passenger. Small dogs 15 pounds or under may be allowed in a small carrier that fits under the passenger’s seat only, and the pet is not allowed out of its carrier at any time in the shuttle. No large animals over 15 pounds are allowed. Each pet is \$20 each way.

Objectionable Passengers: This company reserves the right to refuse to transport persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or who are incapable of taking care of themselves, or whose conduct or behavior may be objectionable to other passengers. The carrier also reserves the right to refuse carriage of any materials that the carrier considers unsafe and not in the best interest of the passengers.

(C)Children: Small children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Children less than 8 years old must be restrained in child restraint systems, unless the child is four feet nine inches or taller. A child who is eight years old or older, or four feet nine inches or taller, must be properly restrained either with the motor vehicle’s safety belt or an appropriately fitting child restraint system. When a child restraint system is required, the adult accompanying the child must provide and install their own car or booster seat, for safety. It is required by our insurance that all occupants, including children, must always wear seatbelts while the shuttle is in motion. We must have an unaccompanied minor form on file for children 12-17 years old.

(C)Baggage/Luggage Allowances: Passengers are allowed one carryon bag and one small personal item, per person. Additional luggage is as follows: carryon \$10, standard suitcase \$15 and extra large items like a ski or golf bag is \$20. All Baggage is subject to inspection for the safety and comfort of all passengers. Materials not allowed on the shuttle for transportation are Firearms (unless locked and stored in the back), packages that are leaking, articles that have foul or obnoxious odors, or items that cause annoyance or harm. W.V.S. is not responsible for lost or damaged luggage or property. However, If a piece of luggage is lost or damaged due to negligence of W.V.S., the company will reimburse up to \$250 for an adult suitcase and \$100 for a child’s. If a passenger would like to declare a value in excess of \$250, you must submit a request to the company, **PRIOR TO TRAVEL**, and it will pay up to a maximum reimbursement of \$1,000. The company is not responsible for any items of extraordinary value including, but not limited to: negotiable instruments, papers, money, manuscripts, documents, jewelry, etc... These items would be transported at your own risk and will not be covered beyond this point.

Food Policy: We allow food and drink to be carefully consumed on the shuttle. The shuttle will make a short 5-10 minute snack and restroom break in Cle Elum, WA. between Wenatchee to/from Sea-Tac Airport.

PASSENGER RULES

Schedule Maintenance: Carrier will not be liable for delays caused by accidents, breakdowns, bad road conditions, snowstorms, or other conditions beyond the control of the carrier and does not guarantee arrival at, or departure from, any point at any specific time. The time schedules provided are schedules the carrier endeavors to maintain but does not guarantee to be able to always do so due to conditions listed above.

Fares: Fares are not all the same prices. Please refer to the rate schedules. However, when booking 3 or more people you receive a 20% discount on each passenger after the second.

Front seat reservation: The front passenger seat, across from the driver, may be reserved for a passenger, but if available and is a first come, first serve request.

Refunds, Ticket limitations, Changes, Cancellations: Subject to the exceptions below, unused tickets will be redeemed at the purchase price and unused portions of round-trip or commutation tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used and refunding the balance of the purchase price. If a reservation is cancelled more than 1 hour prior to shuttle departure time, the reservation can be refunded, minus a \$10 administrative fee per ticket. If a reservation is cancelled in less than 1 hour to shuttle departure time, the reservation will be refunded, minus a \$10 administration fee or coupon to be used within 6 months of the date of travel. Cancellations are not allowed after the scheduled departure time of the reservation, unless it's due to a flight delay or other extenuating circumstance, in which case passengers will be rebooked onto later shuttles as available.

Customers who fail to show up by the scheduled departure time of their reservation at the designated pick-up point or who have not called to cancel or change their reservation prior to shuttle departure time are NOT eligible for a refund. Refunds will be made if the cancellation or change was caused by an airline delay or cancellation, minus the \$10 administrative fee per ticket. The company does not overbook shuttles, therefore if a passenger reserves a seat, and does not show up to use it, it has blocked that seat so other passengers could not utilize it; which causes loss to the company, making this cancellation policy firm. Passengers are free to alter a reservation one time, if needed, at no charge. Any additional changes to that reservation after the first, will be charged a \$10 rebooking fee.

Ticket redemption: Unused tickets will be redeemed at the purchase price, minus a \$10 administrative fee per ticket. Unused portions of round trip or commutation tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used and refunding the balance of the purchase price, minus the administration fee. A coupon code or refund will be issued for cancellations with less than 48 hours' notice, as long as it is prior to shuttle departure time.

Holidays Observed: The shuttle will not run on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day.
