These proposed revised tariff pages contain adjustments to the Douglas County Fee for residential, commercial and drop box garbage collection services. The Douglas County Collection fee is set to expire on March 31, 2025. The letter from Douglas County includes the total fee for 2025. This fee is charged in accordance with Douglas County Solid Waste Collection Fee Ordinance, C.E. 94-014. We request that the new fee take effect April 1, 2025.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers detailing the charge to each service letter as well as the notice received from Douglas County. Upon approval by the Commission of this filing, affected customers will be notified of this rate increase on their next regularly scheduled billing.
