ORDER

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED That the application herein be and the same is hereby granted under the following conditions:

(Note: The impairments subject to this order are located at 6701-99 East Marginal Way South, Seattle, Washington.)

That the downspouts on the face of the wall adjacent to the railroad service tracks at both building locations shall be safety striped from ground level up to an elevation of 14' - 6". Said safety striping shall consist of 4" diagonal bands of alternating contrasting color.

That the cantilever dock platforms adjacent to the service tracks on both buildings shall be safety striped on both sides and across the outboard edge.

That a standard "No Clearance" Sign shall be installed on the corner of both buildings adjacent to the service tracks facing railroad traffic.
