COMPLAINT AND ORDER  
SUSPENDING TARIFF  
REVISIONS

On November 1, 1991, Cascade Natural Gas Corporation filed with the Commission under its Advice No. CNG/W91-11-01, revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-3 designated as Twelfth Revision Sheet No. 595, Cancelling Eleventh Revision Sheet No. 595, Sixty-Fourth Revision Sheet No. 596, Cancelling Sixty-Third Revision Sheet No. 596 and Second Revision Sheet No. 681, Cancelling First Revision Sheet No. 681.

The stated effective date is December 2, 1991.

It appearing that the filing herein would change charges and rates for natural gas service rendered by respondent and that the rights and interests of the public might be injuriously affected thereby, it is the decision of the Commission to enter upon public hearing or hearings concerning such changes and the reasonableness and justness thereof and to suspend the operation of the above tariff revisions pending such hearing or hearings and decision thereon.

In accordance with RCW 80.04.130, the burden of proof to show that such changes are just and reasonable shall be upon the respondent.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The operation of the above tariff revisions, filed herein November 1, 1991, is hereby suspended.
2. A hearing or hearings, on the Commission's own motion, shall be held at such times and places as may be required.

3. No change or alteration shall be made in the tariff revisions filed herein, during the period of suspension, unless authorized by the Commission.
