
RCW 81.70.350 requires that every passenger charter and excursion service carrier operating in this state under jurisdiction of the Commission shall pay an annual regulatory fee to the Commission on or before December 31 of each year, to cover the ensuing year beginning February 1. The amount paid shall not exceed the cost of supervising and regulating such carriers.

The fee covering the 1997 fee year is now before the Commission for consideration. The Commission has considered the number of vehicles anticipated to be operating in the state in 1997 and the anticipated costs of regulating such vehicles. Being fully advised,

IT IS ORDERED That the fee to be paid to the Commission under the provisions of RCW 81.70.350 be raised from \$10 per vehicle to \$10.50 per vehicle.
