Numerous companies provide fiber optic and copper pair connectivity. Carriers that may compete with <u>Black Rock Cable</u>, <u>Inc.</u> include AT&T, MCI Communications, LDDS WorldCom, Sprint, U S West and others.

(C) Prices, Terms, and Conditions of Competing Services:

Terms and conditions of competing services are comparable. Many incumbent carriers offer fiber and copper connectivity. Fiber optic and copper pair connectivity is usually based a contractual arrangement between the parties. Black Rock Cable, Inc. terms and conditions meet Washington regulatory requirements and are stated in the company's proposed price list on file with the WUTC.

(D) Geographic Delineation of the Relevant Market:

<u>Black Rock Cable, Inc.</u>, in conjunction with its federally certified open video system, will offer service throughout the federally certified and locally franchised areas within the State of Washington.

(E) Market Share:

Black Rock Cable, Inc. currently has no customers in Washington.

Black Rock Cable, Inc. does not expect to gain more than a modest share of telecommunications market in Washington.
