WASHINGTON UTILITIES AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION 2007 Liquified Natural Gas Standard Inspection Report Puget Sound Energy – Gig Harbor LNG Peak Shaving Facility Docket No. PG-070050

The inspection included a review of the operating and maintenance manual (O&M), emergency operating plan (EOP), records, and field facility. Two recommendations pertaining to PSE's LNG O&M manual were identified.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. In Section 17.1.2, the first sentence should be revised to read: The material contained in this plan shall be reviewed once every two calendar years, not to exceed 27 months.
- 2. In Section 13.10.5, the second sentence should be revised to read: In order to avoid overfilling or overpressure, manually terminate the flow of LNG by closing block valve V-422 before the liquid level reaches 40.8 in. w.c.
