

Agency: Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission

Subject of possible rule making: The Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) commences this inquiry to consider possible corrections and changes to certain sections in WAC 480-07, the Commission's procedural rules, governing the conduct of business before the Commission, including rules governing formal proceedings. This rulemaking has been assigned Docket A-130355.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.160, and RCW 81.04.160.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: The Commission's last review of WAC 480-07 was in 2006. Since these new rules became effective in August 2006, Commission Staff and interested persons who conduct business before the Commission have identified a number of suggestions to improve and clarify the Commission's procedural rules in WAC 480-07. Based on the number of suggestions received and the length of time since the last revision in 2006, the Commission finds it appropriate to initiate this rulemaking to review its procedural rules.
