The purposes of this filing are to update tariff schedule language in Schedule 152 to, 1) add an alternative for interconnection customers to complete their Schedule 152 application by making the application process available at www.pse.com; 2) eliminate Attachment "L" Estimating Time and Cost for Interconnection Studies and Construction, as PSE has subsequently developed a webpage to provide up-to-date estimated time and cost information about Schedule 152 interconnection studies and facility construction; and 3) incorporate minor housekeeping changes.

In order to facilitate a streamlined process for customers to submit a Schedule 152 interconnection application, PSE has implemented a web-based application process that is in addition to the current "print-and-fill-out" applications in Attachments "B" and "C" to Schedule 152. This streamlined process clarifies the correct and complete customer and generator

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information that is required for submittal. In addition, PSE now utilizes DocuSign - a web-based tool for managing electronic agreements - for all customer and PSE signatures. Other notable benefits of the electronic application include automated emailing that highlights receipt of documents, payment, and managing of deadlines.

PSE is proposing to eliminate Attachment "L" Estimating Time and Cost for Interconnection Studies and Construction. PSE has developed and deployed a webpage for distributed renewables that provides customers with a thorough and up-to-date overview regarding the PSE Schedule 152 interconnection process, including general estimates for the time and cost required for interconnection studies and construction. The PSE website will be updated as estimates and processes change, while ensuring that PSE maintains compliance with WAC rules.

Housekeeping changes can be found on Sheet Nos. 152, 152-B, 152-C, and 152-S.

The tariff sheets described herein reflect an issue date of June 28, 2022, and an effective date of July 29, 2022. Posting of proposed tariff changes, as required by WAC 480-100-193, is being made by posting the proposed tariff sheets on the PSE web site coincident with the date of this transmittal letter. Notice to the public under the provisions of WAC 480-100-194 is not required as this filing does not increase charges or restrict access to services.
