NOTICE OF INTENT TO CANCEL REGISTRATION AS A COMMUNITY SOLAR COMPANY AND OPPORTUNITY TO REQUEST A HEARING

Re: Docket US-220871

King County Housing Authority Olympia Community Solar Sustainable Holdings, LLC

Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has determined that your company has failed to comply with regulatory reporting requirements and/or failed to pay required regulatory fees.

Under WAC 480-103-030, each community solar company must by May 1 file an annual report describing its operations for the preceding year and also pay regulatory fees based on its intrastate revenues for that preceding year.

WAC 480-103-030(3) and WAC 480-07-917(2)(a) provide that the Commission may cancel the registration of a community solar company that fails to file its annual report or pay required regulatory fees. Staff has determined that, as of the date of this notice, each of the abovenamed companies has not filed a complete annual report or paid the regulatory fees that were due by May 1, 2022, or has done neither.

The Commission, therefore, intends to cancel your company's registration. A community solar company may not engage in business without a valid registration per WAC 480-103-020.

To avoid cancelation of your registration, you must take one of the following two actions within 30 days of the date of this notice:

- (1) Come into compliance with applicable law by submitting the delinquent annual report and paying the required regulatory fee (annual report forms as well as information on how to make a payment are available on the Commission's website: www.utc.wa.gov); or
- (2) Request a hearing to demonstrate why your registration should not be canceled. All hearing requests must comply with the Commission's procedural rules,

contained in WAC 480-07, which are available on the Commission's website on its <u>Legal Research Tools</u> page.

If you do not respond to this notice within 30 days of the service date of this notice by complying with the regulatory requirements or by requesting a hearing, the Commission will enter an order canceling your registration without further notice.
