Dear Ms. Maxwell:

We were notified by Island County Public Works that the tipping fees at the Island County Coupeville Transfer Station are increasing, effective January 1, 2023. With this filing, we respectfully request to update the rates under G-154 to reflect the increase in disposal fee from $\$ 147.00$ to $\$ 153.76$ per compacted ton, a $4.60 \%$ increase; and from $\$ 155.00$ to $\$ 162.13$ per loose ton, a $4.60 \%$ increase. This will increase revenue from residential customers by approximately $\$ 67,300$ ( $1.80 \%$ ); commercial customers by $\$ 22,000(1.71 \%)$; and drop box customers by $\$ 44,700(4.62 \%)$ for a 12 -month period. There are approximately 12,100 residential, 700 commercial, and 100 drop box customers affected by this change.

The last general rate increase for G-154 became effective April 1, 2022.
Attached are revised tariff pages and supporting documentation containing the revised rates.
We respectfully ask that this filing be accepted under LSN, per WAC 480-70-276. If the LSN is accepted and these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, the rates will become effective on January 1, 2023. Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii), affected customers will receive notification of this change on the billing reflecting the revised rates.
