RE: Sanitary Service Company, Inc. G-14, Tariff 9 – Item 100 Residential Yard Waste service and Item 230 Yard Waste Pass-through disposal fee.

Dear Secretary Hunter:

Enclosed are revised pages to Solid Waste Tariff No. 9 for Sanitary Service Company, Inc. as well as supporting documentation for the yard waste price increase. The proposed change in the yard waste rate is a result of higher cost of disposal at Green Earth Technology.

This filing proposes the residential food plus or yard waste rate will increase to \$12.87 from \$11.86 for every other weekly service and the yard waste pass-through rate will increase to \$67.00 per ton from \$58.00 per ton.

Residential customer revenue resulting from the cost increases at the third-party disposal site would increase by approximately \$45,000 and the proposed rates would go up 8.52%. The impact to pass through yard waste disposal fee customers for the Item 230 pass-through increase will be approximately \$8,000 and the pass-through rates would go up by approximately 15.52%.

The effective date of these proposed tariff revisions is February 1, 2024.

In accordance with WAC 480-70-271(2), to the extent the Commission approves the rates reflecting the disposal fee, affected customers will be notified of this rate increase on their next regularly scheduled billing.
