1 May 2, 2005, Commission Staff filed a complaint against Weyerhaeuser Paper Company (Weyerhaeuser). The complaint alleges that Weyerhaeuser has committed nine violations of chapter 480-93 WAC, which among other things, adopts certain minimum gas pipeline safety requirements, by adopting by reference specific provisions of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 192 and requires gas companies to comply with such regulations. A more detailed account of the dispute is reflected in the complaint, which is available for inspection at the Commission's office located at Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington, and on the Commission's web site at www.wutc.wa.gov/040984.

2 The Commission has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this Complaint pursuant to the provisions of chapters 80.01 RCW, 80.04 RCW, 80.28 RCW, chapter 480-93 WAC, chapter 480-07 WAC, and chapter 34.05 RCW. Specific provisions include but are not limited to: RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04.070, RCW 80.04.110, RCW 80.04.380, RCW 80.04.385, RCW 80.04.405, RCW 80.04.410, RCW 80.28.010, RCW 80.28.040, 80.28.130, RCW 80.28.207, RCW 80.28.210, RCW 80.28.212, and WAC 480-93-010, WAC 480-93-015, -080, -110, -183, -186, 187, -188.
