UNIVERSAL SERVICE RECEIPTS

The following information is derived from USAC Report HC01 - High Cost Support Projected by State by Study Area for the third quarter of 2007.

- Wireless ETCs operating in the State of Washington are projected to receive \$51,179,436 in High Cost Support on an annual basis
- Rural ILECs operating in the State of Washington are projected to receive \$49,999,940 in High Cost Support on an annual basis
- Four of the seven largest drawers of High Cost Support according to USAC Report HC01 as projected in the third quarter 2007 report are wireless carriers. The ranking is as follows:
