TO ALL PARTIES:

On Tuesday, June 14, 2011, counsel for the Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad filed a Motion to Withdraw Petition. The Commission wishes to offer all parties an opportunity to respond to the railroad's motion, but does not require a response.

In accordance with WAC 480-07-375(4), the presiding officer may vary the five business day response time established by rule. The Commission hereby sets **5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 22, 2011**, as the deadline for electronic submission of responses to the railroad's motion, with an original and **9** paper copies filed with the Commission by noon of the next business day, which is **Thursday, June 23, 2011**.

The Commission anticipates ruling on the railroad's motion in sufficient time to allow all parties and potential intervenors to receive notice of whether or not the prehearing conference currently scheduled for Friday, July 8, 2011, will be conducted or not.
