This email is to voice my concern, as a registered, permanent moving company in Washington State, over the temporary issuance of a permit to Jason M. Nelson dba Parkers' Moving Service.

As a small business owner who pays quarterly taxes into the state's Labor & Industries department, Employment Security, as well as the federal government, I would expect the WUTC staff to hold the same standards for all new moving companies seeking temporary (and eventually permanent) authority. I would hope that this particular moving company be removed from its temporary authority until it can prove that it has registered with the Employment Security department as well as Labor and Industries, and also is following our Tariff by charging customers appropriately. It does a great deal of disservice to those of us who abide by all the rules and regulations in the WUTC tariff when companies such as this one are allowed to operate.
