Dear Mr. Munn:

As you are aware, on May 8, 2015, a Default Judgment was entered against you and Innovative Moving Co. in the Superior Court for Kitsap County. The Default Judgment ordered you to comply with the Commission's Amended Order 02, dated October 11, 2013, in Commission Docket TV-131608, by ceasing and desisting from engaging in business as a household goods carrier without first obtaining a permit from the Commission, required under RCW 81.80.075. The Default Judgment also directed you to pay a civil penalty, including attorneys' fees, in the amount of \$20,570.

The Commission has no record to date that the Company has made any payments in compliance with the court's Default Judgment.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$20,570 balance.
